These trials held under the Rules of the Canadian Kennel Club:

Excerpt from the Rules:

20.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience

or Rally Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

THE FOLLOWING CLASSES WILL BE OFFERED IN OBEDIENCE:

PRE NOVICE - The Pre-Novice Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 5 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of C.D. may enter the Pre-Novice class

NOVICE A - The Novice A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families, and must be eligible to handle under section. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

NOVICE B - The Novice B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B Class at any one trial.

NOVICE C - The Novice C Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title C.D. or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice C Class are not eligible for High In Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered the Novice C Class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE - The Novice Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open Classes. The Novice Intermediate Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a C.D. or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

OPEN A - The Open A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled.

OPEN B - The Open B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher obedience titles may enter in the Open B Class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises.

No dog may be entered in both the Open A and Open B classes at any one trial.

UTILITY A - The Utility A Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned an M.O.T.Ch. title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled

UTILITY B - The Utility B Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

BRACE - The Brace Class is open to any 2 dogs that have earned the title of C.D. or higher. It is not necessary that the same person owns both dogs, nor that they be the same breed, except when entered in a breed specialty obedience trial. The owner or any other person may handle a brace in this class. A person may enter more than one brace in this class. The same handler must handle each brace in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more braces entered. In such case, he must have an additional handler for each extra brace when they are judged together in the Group Exercises. The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as

the Novice Class. The 2 dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on the performance of the 2 dogs as though they were one

TEAM - The Team Class is open to any 4 dogs that have earned the title of C.D. or higher. It is not necessary that the same person own all dogs in the team or that they be of the same breed, except when entered in a breed specialty obedience trial. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered as an alternate. However, the same 4 dogs must compete in all exercises. VETERAN - The Veterans Class shall be for any dog that has earned the title of C.D. or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial.

THE FOLLOWING CLASSES WILL BE OFFERED IN RALLY:

Rally Ring Dimensions are 40 X 50

NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

NOVICE B - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

INTERMEDIATE - The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes. This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. N. title but have not earned the R. A. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

ADVANCED B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

BRACE - Brace class requirements shall be the same as those listed for the Obedience Brace Class, except that they are open to any 2 dogs that have earned a title of R.N. or higher. .

TEAM - Eligibility for Team Classes shall be the same as that listed for the Obedience Team Class, except that the class is open to any 4 dogs that have earned a title of R.N. or higher.

SWEEPSTAKES IS OPEN TO ALL DOGS 7 YEARS OF AGE AND UP REGARDLESS OF PLACE OF BIRTH. ALL DOGS <u>MUST</u> BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS IN THE SHOW ON SUNDAY. THE CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED BY SEX. THE WINNER OF EACH CLASS WILL COMPETE FOR BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES. The classes will be:

> 7 to 10 year old MALE - 7 years up to & under 10 years on June 19 7 to 10 year old FEMALE - 7 years up to & under 10 years on June 19 10 + MALE- 10 years & over on June 19 10 + FEMALE - 10 years & over on June 19

> > PRIZES:

BEST OVERALL IN SWEEPSTAKES - Rosette & 35% of total fees collected 1st IN EACH CLASS - Rosette & 10% of total fees collected A ribbon will be awarded to SECOND through FOURTH IN EACH CLASS. 25% retained by club to defray costs

The Following classes (divided by sex) will be offered in All Breed Conformation:

Regular classes:

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS: Dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS: Dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12-18 MONTH CLASS: Dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED CLASS: Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in the class, but need no handle the dog for further awards. Should the owner/breeder be unable to handle the dog in this class, the dog may be moved to the Open Class (one hour prior to the judging of the breed in question)

OPEN CLASS: All Dogs

SPECIALS ONLY: Dogs, which have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required Points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed. Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy, if eligible. After awarding Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best of winners in each breed, the judge may choose a Select Dog and Select Bitch if there are dogs in the ring eligible for these awards. The Select Dog and Bitch must be awarded in the Specials Only Class. The dog and bitch selected must be champions and cannot be the Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex Winners.

Non-Regular Classes:

BABY PUPPY: Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show

VETERAN CLASS: Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. SUNDAY ONLY

EXHIBITION ONLY: All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in In any regular class but may enter and compete in Non Regular classes.

Unofficial Classes:

BREEDER/OWNER/HANDLER: Breeder/Owner/Handler class will be offered on Saturday and Sunday. As this is an unofficial class you must be entered in an official class to enter as a breeder/owner/handler. Awards will be best in breed, best in group, and best in show. There is no charge for entry in this class.

Altered Classes:

Eligibility for the altered classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure.

12.9 Unofficial Classes

A club may hold an unofficial class, the details of which must be published in the premium list. This class must be held after the Breed/Group, Best in Show and any non-regular class judging.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a confirmation show shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided below:

*DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3 TO 5	6 TO 9	10 TO 12	13 OR MORE
POINTS ALLOCATED	0	1	2	3	4	5

***INCLUDES THE DOG AWARDED WINNERS**

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed, which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at group level:
