This is a titling event conducted under CARO rules and regulations. Exhibitors, through the submission of their entries, acknowledge that they are responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations for CARO. For CARO rules:

CARO trials are open to all dogs being at least six (6) months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds, with a CARO Registration Number, except bitches in season or dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.

Entries close at 5:00 pm October 14, 2024 or when entry limit is reached, whichever occurs

earlier.

Entry Information:

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full (except if waiting for CARO number).
- 2. No entry will be accepted until entry fees are paid.
- 3. Money will not be refunded for cancellation after the closing date.
- 4. Only dogs with a CARO Registration number may be entered.
- 5. Judging schedules will be emailed as soon as possible after entries close.
- 6. Move-ups are allowed day of and during trial. Notify table stewart as soon as possible.
- 7. Fees:
 - a. Rally Obedience: Entries are \$18/run before entries close, \$20/run day of entry.
 - Rally Obedience Team: \$9/dog before entries close, \$10/dog day of entry, \$0/bye dog
 - c. Rally Obedience Brace: \$9/ dog before entries close, \$10/dog day of entry.
 - d. Rally Obedience FEO (for exhibition only): \$10
 - e. Working: \$ 15/round before entries close, \$20/round day of entry (up to 5 exercises).

Rosettes and Ribbons:

Flat ribbons will be awarded for qualifying scores only. A rosette will be provided for 1st in each class and new titles.

Bitches in Season:

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. If a bitch comes into season after the entry has been submitted, the Trial secretary must be notified before the date of the Trial. Whereupon the dog will be pulled and the entry fees will be refunded.

Indignities:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-hosting club to see that any judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall take action as deemed necessary to restore order, including removal of the offending person(s) without refund.

Accommodations for Disabilities:

CARO welcomes and encourages the participation of all dogs and handlers. Should a dog or handler have a physical disability which prohibits the completion of one or more station signs, modifications can be made to the course to reduce or remove components which are impediments to the team's performance.

Common modifications include:

- Reducing the height of depth of the obstacles (e.g., jumps may be reduced to a pole on the ground)

- Reducing the number of sits requested on the course.
- Allowing extra time
- Minimizing the number of stations that include repetitive turns like spirals.
- Allowing for larger turns in stations such as the 270 degree and 360 degree turns

Judges shall make reasonable time modifications for owners or dogs with limited mobility or for larger, slow moving breeds of dogs.

Veteran dogs (7 years of age and older) do not require a modification request to reduce the height of jumps or depth of the broad jump.

Process to Obtain a Modification:

- 1. Final approvals for modifications are at the discretion of the judge.
- 2. Competitors must submit a request for modification with their entry form.
- 3. The request should include:
 - a. A description of the physical challenges involved.
 - b. A description of the modifications being requested.
 - c. Contact information to allow the judge to contact the competitor if need to clarify information and discuss modification options.
 - d. For dogs: in cases where the challenge may cause the dog to appear unsound, such as having an uneven gait, the request should be accompanied by a letter from a veterinarian which states that the dog is able to compete without discomfort. A copy of the letter should be included with each trial entry where the modifications are requested.

Health Reminders:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease, and/or
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within 30 days prior to the event, and/or
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease

KAOS Dogsports Inc. of Regina Information:

There is space available for crating indoors on a first come, first served basis for the rally obedience trials. All dogs must be crated or on leash when not in ring. Handlers are responsible to keep their dogs quiet at all times, clean up after their dogs and exercise them in appropriate areas only. There will be containers to dispose of dog waste.

There will no crating space inside the main building during the working trials. However, there will be limited space available in the kennel room for people to use.

Please bring an indoor set of footwear to keep the flooring as clean as possible throughout the day.

Any dog engaging in aggressive behavior at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds without refund.
