Trial and General Information:

- The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the events that will be governed by CKC rules.
- Posting of testing. Videos or pictures of tests may not be placed on social media or shared until the end of trial. There is to be no discussion of tests until that test level is completed.
- 3. Provided the dog has completed the requirements for the current level of competition, **Move ups** are available to the next level of competition if made at least 15 minutes before the start of the class by completing the required Move-up Form. Please note that move-ups are not permitted within a trial.
- 4. **Day of Entry** permitted if limit has not been reached for that day (\$30.00). This must be completed 1 hour before the trial starts.
- 5. **Trial Precincts:** The buildings being used for the trials and any area(s) that are marked off for exterior components.
- 6. Be prepared to crate from your vehicle. There will be no crating inside the buildings.
- 7. **Parking.** A designated parking area will be available at the venue.
- 8. **Photographer. Ashley McGuiness of Chase the Magic** Photography will be at the trials taking candid photos (some of exterior searches) and will be available for title photos.
- 9. Clean up after your dog and don't let them potty on anything manmade.

- 13.It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Scent Detection Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 14.If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond control of the management, it is impossible to openor to complete the Trials, no refund of entries will be made.
- 15. **Health Protocols.** The Halifax Kennel Club will be following all Federal, provincial, and local health rules when holding the trials.
