# **Rally Obedience Rules**

- The Swansea Dog Obedience Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of, an accident or misfortune however caused to dogs, exhibitors or property. Dogs must be kept under control at all times.
- 2. There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog may be entered as a ±isted dogq except that a dog which has obtained three qualifying scores at obedience trials held under C.K.C. rules, may not continue to compete at licensed obedience trials held under the Clubcs rules until the dog is registered individually with the C.K.C. Foreign born and owned dogs, please refer to Event Registration Number (ERN) information listed elsewhere.
- The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 4. Chapter 17 Section 17.7 of the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 5. Moving Up A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN or a MCN and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the rules may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the trial secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler one hour before the opening of each trial, schedule permitting.
- To comply with CKC regulations, no entries may be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries except for as provided in the CKC Rules.
- 7. These events held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Refunds for bitches in season will be given provided the exhibitor supplies a veterinary certificate stating that the bitch is in season after the closing date of the trials. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of judging for the day.
- 9. The listing fee for a dog not registered with the CKC is \$9.50 per trial (includes HST). A dog must be listed unless it has an individual registration number or an Event Registration Number (ERN) issued by the CKC. Only dogs eligible for registration with the CKC are eligible to compete at these Trials. Failure to obtain an ERN within 30 days of the event will result in any scores being cancelled by the CKC. Please note that dogs are not allowed to compete above the Novice level without a CKC registration number or an ERN. Applications for an ERN can be obtained from the CKC.
- 10. Non-member participation fee . an annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titled to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.
- 11. Only those dogs entered in the Trials will be allowed within the precincts of the trial. This area includes the obedience floor, the arena stands and surrounding concrete areas outside the arena boards and glass enclosure.
- 12. Exhibitors should follow their veterinariansqrecommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

## **Rally Obedience Classes**

Rally Novice A

Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog its through the CKC CDX title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible for this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Rally Novice B

Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Rally Advanced A

For dogs which have won the title of RN in Canada, but have not won the title (Rally Advanced) or any CKC Novice Obedience Title. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible for this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Advanced B

This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Rally Excellent A

This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title but not the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. No handler who has exhibited a dog its through the CKC CDX title or instructed dog training classes shall be eligible for this class. A dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class after official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title (R.E.). No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at one trial. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Rally Excellent B

This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

The Obedience Chairman shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of these Regulations, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this Regulation has been violated.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Refunds for bitches in season will be given provided
  the exhibitor supplies a veterinary certificate stating that the bitch is in season after the closing date of
  the trials. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of
  judging for the day.
- 4. The listing fee for a dog not registered with the CKC is \$9.50 per trial (includes HST). A dog must be listed unless it has an individual registration number or an <u>Event Registration Number</u> (ERN) issued by the CKC. Only dogs eligible for registration with the CKC are eligible to compete at these Trials. Failure to obtain an ERN within 30 days of the event will result in any scores being cancelled by the CKC. Please note that dogs are not allowed to compete above the Novice level without a CKC registration number or an ERN. Applications for an ERN can be obtained from the CKC.

- 7. Novice %A+is for dogs and handlers where the dog has not achieved a CD title and the handler has not put a CDX title on any dog. Novice %B+is for dogs and handlers where the dog has not achieved a CD title and the handler has put a CDX title on any dog. Novice "C" is for any dog which has earned a CD, CDX, UD or any obedience trial championship title prior to the closing date of the trials. A dog eligible for entry in the Open or Utility classes is also eligible for entry in the Novice "C" class at the same trial. Novice Intermediate is for dogs which have earned the title of CD, CDX, UD or any obedience trial championship. Dogs entered in Novice C or Novice Intermediate classes are not eligible for High in Trial awards.
- 8. Open %+is for dogs and handlers where the dog has achieved a CD title and not achieved a CDX title and the handler has not put a UD title on any dog. Open %+is for dogs and handlers where the dog has achieved a UD title, and for dogs and handlers where the handler has put a UD title on any dog.
- 9. Utility %+is for dogs and handlers where the dog has achieved a CDX title and not achieved a UD title, and for dogs and handlers where the handler has not put a MOTCH title on any dog. Utility %+is for dogs and handlers where the dog has achieved a CDX and a UD title, and for dogs and handlers where the handler has put a MOTCH title on any dog

In each class in each Trial, a trophy and rosette will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place dog and a rosette will be awarded to the  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  placed dogs.
