

## COVID-19 Information

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

1. Please adhere to COVID-19 health & safety measures, including proper physical distancing, wearing a mask, and remaining at home if you show symptoms of cold or flu. If you are unwell, you may be asked to leave the show grounds.
2. Exhibitors may be asked to SHOW & GO to maintain the COVID-19 gathering limits set by the province.
3. Each exhibitor MUST complete the car registration form. This is how you will get entry to the show site.
4. Each participant must sign a waiver.
5. There will be NO spectators allowed on the grounds. If you do not have a dog entered or an assigned job on the grounds, you will not be admitted.
6. You will only be allowed on the grounds one hour prior to your show time. If you have extra grooming, please do it at home or arrange to do it where you are staying. There will be no forced air dryers allowed on the grounds.
7. Access to show grounds will be allowed only on the day of the show. There will be NO CAMPING available.
8. Masks are MANDATORY in the ring area, the bathrooms and when you can't socially distance.
9. Hand sanitizer stations will be available in the ring area and bathrooms. Please bring your own to use when you are at your vehicle.
10. Social distancing MUST be followed while on the show site and in the ring area. Avoid congregating. There will be no seating available around the ring.
11. Bring your own food and drinks. There will be no concession available.
12. Obey ENTER and EXIT gates in the ring.
13. Ribbons and rosettes will be set out on a table as you exit the ring after placements. If you DO NOT want your ribbon or rosette please leave it on the table and DO NOT touch it.
14. Ring areas will be disinfected during breaks. Participants are expected to follow these event guidelines. Failure to comply may result in excusal from the show.
