OTHER ENTRY INFORMATION:

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full and accompanied by a signed waiver and entry fees. Telephone entries cannot be accepted
- Cheques dated after the close of entries will not be accepted.
 Tendering of an NSF cheques will be considered non-payment of entry and can result in cancellation of awards. All NSF/ returned cheques are subject to a \$40 service charge. There will be no refund of overpayments or duplicate entries
- 3. An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time published in the premium list. Written or electronic notification MUST be received by the Event Secretary by the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event(s). Entries that are cancelled before the closing date will be refunded.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB INFORMATION

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE POLICY

Effective January 1, 2011

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$59.40, plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN)

Effective November 1, 2019, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Temporary Competition number (TCN). This TCN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an TCN, go to the CKC website and register online. This number will automatically be generated once submitted and will be a 9 character registration number such as TC-AB1234567

MIXED AND UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS

These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC studbook it may be entered as a listed dog per CKC rules for this designation, as of July 1, 2018; exhibitors must apply to the CKC for "

TITLES SHALL BE AWARDED ON THE BASIS OF THE FOLLOWING:

temporary competition number (TCN), before event closing date".

Three titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Chase Ability Program event the required number of times. For purebred dogs, these are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.

- Chase Ability (CA) Awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges.
- 2. Chase Ability Excellent (CAX) Dog pass the CA event a total of 10 times (CA + 7 additional passes)
- 3. Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX2) Dog passes the CA event a total of 20 times. A higher number title will be awarded for every ten (10) passes.


RIBBONS:

Flat ribbons for qualifying run
Rosette will be awarded for dogs completing the Chase Ability Program title.
MUST BE PRESENT at AWARDS to receive ribbons/prize

COURSE, ELIGIBILITY & CONDITIONS

COURSE

The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of event. Course will be reversed for the second event. Course is upside down.



ELIGIBLE BREEDS: Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC; or have an Temporary Competition Number (TCN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. Dogs run as singles.

300-YARD COURSE: This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the wither's or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. **Dogs will run one loop.**

600-YARD COURSE: This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. **Dogs will run both loops**.

If there is a question as to which course a dog will run the judge will decide.

<u>CONDITIONS:</u> All dogs will run individually. Slip leads recommended when starting your dogs. Muzzles may be used at owner's discretion. Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. NO EXCEPTIONS. Lame dogs or bitches in season during roll call will be excused and their entry fees refunded.

DIRECTIONS, HOTELS, CAMPING:

DIRECTIONS: (GPS 45 04 09.44N 74 16 37.36W)

From 401:

Take exit 750 (Morrisburg), go NORTH (toward Winchester) about 22 km Turn R. onto River Rd. (1st rd. after Cass Bridge; previous Rd. = Nesbitt, also known as airport rd., on R. also); there will be a bridge across the river (South Nation) on your R. This is Nation Valley Rd. Take this bridge, keep on curve to the L. 12758 will be the 1st place on R. after that curve enter driveway, go past the house (2 story red brick), past the barn, drive on lane way along fence till you see the field.

From Ottawa:

31 south (Bank St.) to 4 km south of Winchester (do not turn into Winchester, stay on 31); turn L. onto River Rd. opposite that cheese house, then as above.

From Kemptville:

Hwy 43 east to 31, turn R onto 31 (south) - then as above.

From Alexandria or Monkland:

Hwy 43 west to Chesterville; just past 1st exit off 43 for Chesterville, Nation Valley Rd. is on the L., Eastern Ontario Graphics on SE corner. 12758 is about 5 km down, on the L.

From Cornwall: 401 to exit 770 (Dickinson Rd, Ingleside); turn R at end of ramp onto CR 14. In approx 3 km turn L onto CR 18, toward Gallingertown. After approx 8 km (??) turn R onto CR 11 toward Finch, Chesterville. Turn L at hwy 43; L onto Nation Valley Rd after passing signs for Chesterville.
