| Open Derby | To follow upon completion of Open Shooting Dog Stake. (for dogs not over 27 months of age on September 21, 2012) | \$40.00 |

Courses and Birds: Single course in cover. Released birds will be quail. Other game birds may be present. No birds will be released for the puppy stake. In the event of adverse course conditions, the Field Trial Chairman may adjust the courses (including adding or deleting bird field) to suit.

Location: Firefly Kennels, 636 Southside Road, Upper Stewiacke, Nova Scotia. The club wishes to thank Darren and Crystal Miller for use of the grounds. A map to the trial grounds will be forwarded to all participants along with the running order prior to the event.

Accommodations: Camping will be allowed on the grounds on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights and will be restricted to marked areas. Facilities are limited so please come prepared. General Information:

- Running and Handling: Horseback handling will not be permitted in any stakes.
- Please be ready for your brace in case of early pickup of previous brace(s). The running of the trial will not be held up waiting for handlers at the line.
- .22 caliber or larger blank pistols will be fired over all dogs with bird work in senior and derby stakes. Blank pistols may be fired over puppies if both handlers agree
- No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake. Pistols must have solid barrels
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours.
- The senior and derby stakes will be 30 minutes in length; the puppy stake will be 20 minutes in length. The Club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the junior stakes should conditions warrant.
- Collaring a dog away after game contact will be allowed.
- Bitches in season will not be permitted to run.

- Tracking Collars: CKC approved electronic tracking collars may be used. Participants must declare that they
 are using the tracking collars to the Field Trial Chairman and also to the judges. Garmin GPS collars are not
 approved for use in Canada and will not be permitted. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to
 the Field Trial Secretary.
- Bells: Due to the nature of a cover course, bells are permitted to be worn on the collar.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that any judge, marshal, club official, volunteer, or any other participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind.

Reminder: There will be no exercising or training of any dogs on the grounds before, during, or after the Trial without the permission of the Field Trial Chairman or the Field Trial Secretary. All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules & provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial rulebooks are available from the CKC or online at the CKC website for CKC members.

Prizes: Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to the placing dogs in all stakes. Suitable prize will be awarded to the first placing dog in each stake. Prize will be awarded to the overall dog of the day as decided by the judges. In association with the GSPCC and VC tests, a suitable prize will be offered to the highest qualifying Irish Setter of the weekend in the field tests offered by VC and GSPCC

Entries: Will be limited to 8 hours of judging time. Entries should be submitted to Field Trial Secretary at the address listed below between 8am, Monday July 16, 2012 and 8pm Monday September 17, 2012:

Entries will close at 8:00pm sharp on Monday, September 17, 2012 and the draw will be held immediately after the close at the home the field trial secretary.

Entry fees: Are to be paid in Canadian funds by cash, cheque or money order payable to the Atlantic Pointing Breed Club and must accompany entry. The Entry Line may also be used (contact info listed below).

Listing Fee: A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is \$9.65 (including HST) per dog per each event entered during the field trial and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

Meals - A barbeque lunch and refreshments will be available for purchase at a reasonable cost.

All entries for this Field Trial are accepted on condition that the Irish Setter Club of Canada, its officials and members, and landowners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this Field Trial. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or quardian.
