Entries will only be accepted when payment in full is received. Payments must be received within 48 hours of entry. This is a CKC requirement. You will receive a confirmation of entry usually within 48 hours of payment. Please email dlmagility@gmail.com ONLY if you do not receive a confirmation of entry by Apr 14, 2023. A judging schedule with trial starting time will be sent to all confirmed entries at least 6 days before the trial.

E-transfer payment to: dlmagility@gmail.com If you are asked for a password, please use AGILITY. Please put the date of this agility trial in the comments so we know what to apply it to. There are NO extra fees for e-transfers. We will not be accepting any paper or emailed entries. All fees are payable in Canadian Funds. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied with payment in full within 48 hours, confirmation and judging schedule will only be sent to entries that are accompanied by full payment. Unpaid entries will be deleted without notice. We do not accept cheques or cash for payments.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to start or to complete this event, no refund of entry will be made.

The Trial Secretary, Dara Murphy, is in full charge of the Trials. Trial precincts consist of the Red Barn property. Whistles, clickers, "squeaky" toys, flexis and prong collars are NOT permitted within 20 feet of any active agility ring and no food or toys within 10' of the ring gates. (Non squeaky toys are permitted in ring with judge approval for FFO runs). Bitches in season are NOT permitted anywhere on the trial precincts. Ring is grass covered. Ring enclosure is snow fencing & there will be gates that close on each ring. Ring dimensions are 100 ft x 100 ft. Handlers in all classes may walk the course without their dog prior to the start of their class. There will be NO obstacle familiarization. Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules & Regulations effective January 1st, 2020. The broad jump and wall jump will not be offered at this trial. There is no cover provided for rain or inclement weather.

To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 months of age and eligible for a registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Misc. Certificate, TCN, or a CKC Performance Event Number. Spayed bitches, debarked dogs and neutered males are eligible to compete. Mixed breed dogs may enter these trials with a CKC Canine Companion Number.

HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

No entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries, except as provided in the rules. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how and by whom the errors were made.

Senior handlers 65 and older or handlers with a disability: can request a modified course time or point requirement as of Jan. 1 2020. Please ensure you check the box on the entry form to qualify for this if you wish.

Vendors: There will be not vendors at this event.

Check in: Is at the registration desk by the kitchen door

Course maps: Course maps will be handed out at check in after the novice warm up run.

UNOFFICIAL Warm up run available for dogs entered in the standard novice run only. Limited entry, please notify the trial secretary, Dara Murphy at the trial if you wish to enter. Entries will be accepted with \$10.00 cash only exact change only on day of trial only (for unofficial warm up run only) The warm up run will be run before the Official Novice Standard run.

Move-ups: Move-ups will be allowed between classes.

Results: Results will be posted on the table. They will also be posted on the Red Ban Event Centre website.

Prizes & Ribbons Through the generosity of the ONNSDTR Club members qualified placement runs 1st to 4rth will receive a rosette and a prize. Qualifiers after 4th place will receive a flat (qualifier) ribbon and a prize. New title ribbons will be available from the ON NSDTR Club at no charge.

Refunds: Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed, a Vet's certificate certifying the bitch was in season within a 10-day period preceding the trials must reach the trial secretary on or before the start of the first trial. A full refund of entry & listing fees will be given.

As of January 1, 2020, as per CKC regulations if a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3-day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The club will refund the entry minus the TCN fee and a 30% administration fee.

<u>From the 400:</u> Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27.(aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

<u>From Hwy 27</u>: When traveling North on CR 27 you must turn left shortly after passing through the town of Thornton. Look for the 20th Sideroad on your left and then the 10th Line on your right, that's your cue to slow down. Then you will see a small sign on your right that shows you must turn left to stay on CR 27. Turn left on CR 27 and continue north. After passing Mapleview Dr. W. you will go down a big hill, the Red Barn is on your left at the bottom of the hill.

Red Barn Event Centre rules

- 1) PLEASE drive slowly down the long driveway. 10 km limit!
- 2) There is a private residence at the front of the property. Do not walk your dogs down the driveway towards the residence as it upsets the dogs who live there.
- 3) Only Park in the designated parking area.
- 4) Dogs must be on leash (no flexi leashes are allowed) at all times, except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 5) No prong collars are allowed on the Red Barn Event Centre property
- 6) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is friendly.
- 7) Please pick up your dog's waste. Disposal bags and sites are readily available. Green garbage cans are doggy waste only.
- 8) Please clean up after yourself. Please take home your garbage and recycling (other than doggy waste-green garbage bins).
- 9) No smoking or vaping anywhere on the trial site and Red Barn Event Centre property.
- 10) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 11) Be nice to our volunteers. Remember if you want to be treated with respect give others the same respect.
- 12) If there is anything, we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 13) Agility is a team sport, so please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home.
