For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dogs' foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$55.85 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY.)

Non Member Participation Fee (April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.

- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee.
 - Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 to 15 MONTH CLASS (Labrador Retriever Club of Canada) - This class shall be for any dog 12 months but under 15 months of age on the day of the show 15 to 18 MONTH CLASS (Labrador Retriever Club of Canada) - This class shall be for any dog 15 months but under 18 months of age on the day of the show 12 to 18 MONTH CLASS- This class shall be for any dog 12 months but under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/cobreeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

VETERANS CLASS - This class is open to all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Points are not awarded from this class, but rather the winner from the Veteran Male and Veteran Female class will proceed to the Best of Breed judging.

Note: Dogs entered in this class MAY be spayed or neutered.

VETERANS CLASS (competitive) (Golden Retriever Club of Canada/Golden Retriever Club of B.C. BC): shall be for all dogs 7 years of age to and including 9 years of age, 10 & 11 years of age and 12 years of age and over. These dogs will compete for regular placements with the first place males and females in each age division competing for Best of Breed. Best Veteran in Specialty and Best Opposite Veteran in Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Classes DO NOT compete for Championship points. (dogs entered in this class may be SPAYED OR **NEUTERED**)

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(if offered by the club, refer to individual Premium List section)

NOTE: Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only on the same day, dogs being entered in a Parade may be spayed, neutered or in an unorthodox trim PROVIDED they are entered in **Exhibition Only.**

STUD DOG & GET CLASS - This class shall be for a Stud Dog and two or more of his Get. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes.

BROOD MATRON & PROGENY - This class shall be for a Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. The Progeny **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

HUNTING DOG CLASS (Clumber Spaniel Club of Canada) - The Hunting Dog Class is open to any dog or bitch that has received a Hunting title from either the Canadian Kennel Club or the American Kennel Club.

GUN DOG CLASS - This class shall be for any dog with a recognized CKC and/or AKC title (i.e. WC, WCI, WCX, JH, SH, MH and the various field titles (i.e. FD, FTCH, AFTCH) FIELD DOG AND FIELD BITCH CLASS (Gordon Setter Club of Canada) - This class is open to Gordon Setter Male or Female which have received a placement in an official class at a licensed field trial in Canada or the United States or which have earned a Hunting Dog test title in Canada or the United States prior to July 20, 2012 FIELD DOG AND FIELD BITCH CLASS (Golden Retriever Club of Canada) - Shall be

for a dog of either sex with a CKC/AKC MH, CKC/AKC Licensed Field Trial Placement. *******************

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

(description of event pertaining to those Specialties that offer this event)

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed judging.

Two classes ONLY will be offered

Altered Male or Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will compete together for Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite Sex Altered in Breed.

REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT SAME TRIAL

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. The dog does not have to be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class. **One dog ONLY** may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES**. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a CDX title may not handle dogs in this class but MUST COMPETE IN THE NOVICE "B" CLASS

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs that have not earned the title of "CD" in Canada. Dogs in this class may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog does not have to be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

<u>OPEN "A"</u> - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. **One dog <u>ONLY</u> may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES**. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title may not handle dogs in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>OPEN "B"</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS**. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'A'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

<u>UTILITY CLASS 'B'</u> - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

(IF OFFERED BY THE CLUB)

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS or FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF VETERANS OBEDIENCE.

<u>GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have not gained a qualifying score toward the "CDX" title in Canada BUT that has obtained the title "CD" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

<u>GRADUATE OPEN CLASS</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have not obtained a qualifying score toward the "UD title in Canada BUT which has obtained the title "CDX" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

<u>VERSATILITY CLASS</u> - This class is open to all dogs that have attained the title of "CDX" in Canada and at least 1 leg on the Utility title, or that has obtained the "UD" title in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

BRACE CLASS - This class is open to any two dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own both dogs.

<u>TEAM CLASS</u> - This class is open to any four dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own all four dogs.

<u>VETERANS CLASS</u>- This class shall be for all dogs that have an Obedience title and that are at least 7 years of age prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class".

NOTE (effective January 1, 2005): DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN ANY OF THE REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: The word 'trainer' means any person who conducts or has conducted a dog obedience training class or who regularly assists with the training of dogs in said class or who regularly trains dogs belonging to any person outside his/her immediate family



TRANSITION OBEDIENCE CLASSES

<u>PRE-NOVICE</u> - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" - This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" AT SAME TRIAL

RALLY NOVICE A: Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY NOVICE B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY ADVANCED B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

(description of event pertaining to those Specialties that offer this event)

This is an event that is open to all dogs regardless of their place of birth that are over 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of their Specialty. (*Please refer to the entry fee schedule page*) for a listing of classes available at each of the Specialties.

Please note, that each of the age divisions will be divided by sex.

SPECIAL NOTE: All dogs **MUST** be entered in one of the official regular conformation classes, to be eligible for this event.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

(description of event pertaining to those Specialties that offer this event)

This is an event that is open to all dogs over 7 years of age regardless of their place of birth on the day of their Specialty (*Please refer to the entry fee schedule page*) for a listing of classes available at each of the Specialties

Note: That each of the age divisions will be divided by sex (unless otherwise stated)

<u>SPECIAL NOTE:</u> Spayed or neutered dogs may compete in this event, however they **MUST** also be entered in Veterans Class (competitive) or Exhibition ONLY



OVERNIGHT R.V. PARKING

RV PARKING: RV SITES WILL BE ASSIGNED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. All RV parking must be reserved in advance and those wishing to park together should submit their reservations together. <u>Deadline for reservations will be June 27, 2012</u>. **THERE ARE NO POWER HOOKUPS, and all RV's must be self-contained**. - 9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, THERE IS NO REFUND OF FNTRY
- 10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

ALL EXHIBITORS. HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING* 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more POINTS AWARDED

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 4 1 3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$9.40 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules. (Effective January 1, 2011)

Section 8.2:

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled. **Section 8.6.2**:

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 14.1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

CHAPTER 5 - SHOW OFFICIALS

Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.
