Day of trial entries will be accepted if the schedule allows. All such entries must be presented to the Trial Secretary no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start time for that trial, along with a fee of \$36.00.

Non Member Participation Fee:

As of January 1, 2011 the CKC has imposed a non member participation fee. "These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

Attention U.S.A. Exhibitors - Please note that fees are due and payable in **Canadian dollars**. Due to fluctuating currency rates, **discounted cheques will not be accepted**. If you send a cheque it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and any other applicable fees. No exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

Border Crossing - A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate which must be dated at least 30 days prior to entering Canada.

E.R.N. Numbers - The cost of obtaining an Event Registration Number (ERN) with the CKC has been increased to \$59.40 plus 5% GST Canadian funds. To obtain an ERN, send a copy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN. Include payment in full. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or Mastercard number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining awards or qualifying scores to avoid cancellation.

PEN Numbers - The cost of obtaining a Performance Event Number (PEN) is \$53.90 plus 5% GST. The PEN allows an unregistrable dog of CKC recognized breed to participate in those competitive events appropriate to the breed. A completed PEN application form must be submitted to CKC whereupon after completing documentation CKC will assign a PEN number.

BITCHES IN SEASON - Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. "When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The trial giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

CONCESSION

Lunch and snacks will be available on site.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Parking for a few self-contained trailers, RV's and vans is available at the show site at a cost of \$13.00/night. Reservations must be made with the Trial Secretary at least 1 week before the trial. No hookups available. No facilities available overnight.

ALL BREED OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

The following regular CKC classes (not divided by sex) will be provided for purebred dogs of any breed and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous class breeds of either sex. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B, Open A and Open B, or Utility A and Utility B at any one trial.

All exhibitors are required to be familiar with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2014.

Obedience Classes: Regular

Pre Novice, Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, Open A, Open B, Utility A and Utility B

Refer to Sections 9 to 13 of the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for full details.

EXHIBITION ONLY: This is an official class. A dog may be entered for Exhibition Only, which must be specified on the entry form. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered for competition. No dog so entered can compete in any Regular class, however it may be entered in and compete in any Unofficial Class . A listing fee is not required for a listed dog entered in Exhibition Only (not entered for any competition).

RULES GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the trial. The trial chairperson shall have full control of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the chairperson or veterinarian for any reason, shall not, after being excused compete in any class for any award the balance of the trial.
3. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability for, either dogs, exhibitors or patrons in the event of an accident or misfortune.
4. Dogs must be on the grounds one hour prior to the judging of their respective class.
5. The owner of a dog entered in these trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
6. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
7. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only, not in the show building.
8. If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, if it is impossible to open or complete the trials, there is no refund of entry.
9. Dogs must be on leash at all times on the grounds except while in the obedience ring.
10. **PRECINCTS OF THESE TRIALS WILL BE THE INSIDE THE BUILDING AND SURROUNDING PARKING AREA OR ANY OTHER AREA DESIGNATED BY THE CLUB**
