First in each class 25% of entry fee & rosette Second in each class 20% of entry fee & rosette Third in each class 15% of entry fee & rosette Fourth in each class 10% of entry fee & rosette

TO COMPETE IN ANY SWEEPSTAKES CLASS, DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS, OR FOR SPECIALS ONLY. ENTRY IN JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED EXCEPT FOR PUPPIES AGED 3-6 MONTHS - THESE PUPPIES MAY ENTER FROM THE BABY PUPPY CLASS, OR FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MOS.) CLASS. VETERANS MAY BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR SPECIALY CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

3 - 6 months 6 - 9 months 9 - 12 months 12 - 18 months

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

7 – 10 years 10 years & older

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes.

Sire & Get Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same

owner.

Dam & Progeny Brood bitch and two of more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by

the same owner.

Brace Two dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed), <u>not necessarily owned by</u>

the same owner.

<u>Please note:</u> An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary before the official date and time of entry closing. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.</u>

<u>ERRORS IN ENTRIES</u>: An error in an <u>age-specified class, date of birth or sex</u>, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- 2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 3. A judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under CKC rules shall not be subject to any indignity (CKC dog show rules, 19.7).

<u>ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS</u>

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$59.40 plus 5% GST ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. CKC Non-Member Participation Fee
