

DIRECTIONS

From Toronto or From the East: Exit the HWY 401 westbound to the HWY 410 and go north. Take the extension that connects to HWY 10 north. Continue until you reach King St. Turn left. Stay on King St. into Terra Cotta. At the stop sign in Terra Cotta go straight through, staying on King St. After the bend in the road to the left you are now on Winston Churchill Blvd. You will cross the bridge over the Credit River and continue up the hill. Just past the top of hill you will see #12900 on your right. If you reach the 80 km speed limit sign you have passed our driveway.

From West: Take HWY 401 east to Trafalgar Rd (exit #328 from 401) and go north about 6.5 km to the 10th Side Rd. Turn right and continue to Norval. Turn left onto Winston Churchill (also called Adamson St at this point) and keep going until you reach #12900, which is on your left.

From Niagara: If you take the QEW east to Bronte Rd (HWY # 25 Milton), and travel north to Britannia Rd., turn right at the light. Continue to Trafalgar Rd and turn left (north). Once you pass over the HWY 401 follow the directions 'Coming from West'. **OR** take HWY 407 east to HWY 401 East exit and then exit the 401 at Winston Churchill Blvd. and travel north to #12900.

NOTE: the house numbers on the left and right sides of Winston Churchill do not follow numeric order, so look at the numbers on the west side!

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (continued)

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. If you pay by personal American cheque, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. **Do not write "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par".** This is not acceptable and will not clear the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to buy bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Or use The ENTRY LINE (see below)

BORDER CROSSING: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Canadian Food Inspection Agency regulations can be viewed at: <http://www.inspection.gc.ca/english/animal/heasan/import/dogse.shtml>

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Owned Dogs): For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born/owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of entering a first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (Canadian funds) along with the completed application form. The form can be downloaded from www.ckc.ca/forms or from the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

REGULATIONS: It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC *Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations* are available from the Canadian Kennel Club at 1-800-250-8040 and online at www.ckc.ca

CKC REGULATION 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

NEW CKC Non-member Participation Fee:

Effective January 1 2011, an annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a **CANADIAN non-member of CKC**. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to become a CKC member or pay the non-members participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Participants using THE ENTRY LINE will be required to sign the "Earthdog Participation Agreement" prior to competing.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (continued)

MOVE UPS: Move ups are permissible one (1) hour before the class provided that the dog has not already entered that test.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

AWARDS: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry test will receive flat ribbons. Qualifiers in Junior, Senior and Master Earthdog tests will receive rosettes and an individual prize. Dogs that earn an Earthdog title will receive an individual prize. In order to be awarded a CKC earthdog title Canadian Non-CKC members must pay a CKC fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and is not applicable to CKC members.

TEST PRECINCT: The precinct of this test will be the marked section of 'WILLOWBRAE', Terra Cotta, ON. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

VALIDATION OF ENTRIES: All participants are required to fill and sign the Earthdog Participation Agreement on the reverse of the entry form. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the tests.

TEST SITE: Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be **under control and on a leash** at all times, except during the test. As is the case with most earthdog tests, the ground at the site is uneven. Wear appropriate footwear. No flexi leashes are permitted anywhere on the property.
Fencing will be placed around the IQ test location only.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test, must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

PARKING: Limited parking will be available within the grounds of Willowbrae. Please follow signs and parking sheriff's instructions. If you have to park on Winston Churchill please use caution and park in front of Willowbrae. The parking area is outside the Test Precinct.

- Tests are open to all purebred Dachshunds and those Terriers in Group IV and on the Miscellaneous list seeking eligibility for Group IV that are small enough to fit into a 9 inch drain (6.6.1)
- Spayed, neutered and debarked dogs are eligible to participate.
- Dogs must be 6 months or older.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (continued)

TEST INFORMATION:

Introduction to Quarry (IQ – Not an official CKC Test)

This test is a simple instinct test requiring no training or previous exposure to earthwork. Young dogs with no previous working experience and novice handlers are encouraged to enter.

Open to all eligible dogs that have not completed requirements for a JE title or higher title.

Junior Earthdog (JE)

Open to all eligible dogs that have not completed the requirements for the CKC Senior title. A dog that has completed the requirements for JE is not required to move up to the next level but may no longer compete in IQ.

Senior Earthdog (SE)

Open to dogs that have completed the requirements for Junior Earthdog title. A dog that has completed the requirements for SE is not required to move up to the next level but may no longer compete in JE or IQ.

Master Earthdog (ME)

Open to dogs that have earned a CKC SE title or ME title.
