Distinguished Panel of Judges

BMDCC National Specialty - All Conformation Classes Judge: Michael Forte, Dublin, Ireland



Dogs have always been a part of Michael Forte's life. Growing up, his family had Cocker Spaniels, Rough Collies, and German Shepherds Dogs. Over the years, he has shown and bred Old English Sheepdogs, Tibetan Spaniels, Cavalier king Charles Spaniels and Bernese Mountain Dogs.

Thirty years ago, Michael introduced Bernese Mountain Dogs to Ireland, where he bred the first litters and titled the first champions in that country. In 1980, he started the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Ireland; he is currently the BMDCI President.

Mr. Forte is qualified to judge all breeds up to and including the Best in Show level. As an FCI all breed judge, he has been invited to shows in many countries around the world, including European and World shows, and many International shows. He has also judged at all breed shows in Africa, America, Canada, and Asia.

Michael has judged Bernese in most European countries, also in Australia and New Zealand. He judged the 2010 Club Specialty Show for Bernese Mountain Dogs in Celje, Slovenia. In July 2012, he judged Bernese at the Championnat de France show in Metz. In September 2012, he judged the BMD Specialty in Langenthal, Switzerland. He was back in Switerland again in August 2013 judging Bernese (puppies and veterans) at the Euro Show in Geneva. In 2015, he judged the breed at the Richmond UK Championship show with 90 BMDs entered. Mr. Forte judged males and Best of Breed at the World Dog Show in Leipzig, Germany on 12 November 2017 where 367 Bernese were entered (the 4th largest breed entry at this World Show that had a record number of 24,692 total dogs competing).s in Moscow.

We are very fortunate to have **Anne Summers** (Summers Bernese Mountain Dogs, USA) to judge our 2018 Sieger Show.

You will receive a written and a verbal evaluation of each dog entered in the show based on key points in the breed standard for the education of the owners and spectators.

Classes: (The classes are divided by age and sex) **Jungstenklasse:** (Youngest) for dogs 6-15 months of age. **Jugendklasse:** (Youth) - for dogs 15-18 months of age. **Offen Klasse:** (Open) - for dogs 18 months or older that have not yet received a Championship title. **Siegerklasse:** (Specials) - for dogs with a recognized championship ie, CKC/AKC **Veteranenklasse:** (Veterans) - for dogs 7 years and older

Note: Altered dogs as well as intact dogs are equally welcome to participate in all classes. Bernese Mountain Dogs must be registered or have a Performance Event Number (PEN) to enter the show.



Additional Information

Attention foreign exhibitors - as per Section 8.3.1 of the CKC Conformation Rules, every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following: a) registered with the CKC, b) have an Event Registration Number, c) be eligible for registration with the CKC.

Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided: a) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration; b) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC; c) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. Section 8 4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

NOTICE TO U.S. EXHIBITORS RE: ERN NUMBERS Dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Please forward your request to:

PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES BY U.S. EXHIBITORS: Current exchange rate favors the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they must be payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds, or 'at par' as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated!



So basically, the US exhibitors can enter their dog as "listed" but if they win any awards or points they must apply for an URN number or register their dog with the CKC within 30 or they will lose it.

BORDER CROSSING: A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this certificate and it MUST be updated at least thirty days prior to re-entry into the U.S.

There will be 4 All breed shows plus the Specialty Show, a great opportunity to pick up some points towards your Canadian Championship.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB-SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS Chapter 15 – Champions and Championship points

SECTION 1 A dog awarded winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 1 to 5) and the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded Winner shall be as follows:

			6 to 9	10 to 12	13+
Points Allocated 0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges and must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.
