### Classifications

The following classes (divided by sex) are offered:

All regular classes as indicated in the Lakehead Kennel Club Premium List:

(i.e. Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12 – 18 Months, Bred By, Canadian Bred, Open, Specials) & Exhibition Only

### Plus

**Veterans Class** For dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. (Dogs entered in this class may be neutered/spayed) Classes further divided by age (7-10 and 11 & over). Best Veteran Male & Female will compete for Breed. Best Veteran in each breed will compete for Best Veteran in Specialty.

**Altered Classes** All dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

### Veteran Sweeps

Classes (divided by sex) are: 7 to10 years, and 11 and over.

All dogs must be entered in the Specialty or in Exhibition Only; Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

**Prizes:** Trophy & Rosette for Best In Sweeps; Rosette for Best of Opposite in Sweeps

1<sup>st</sup> in each class – 30% of entries for that class; 2<sup>nd</sup> in class – 20% of entries for that class

3<sup>rd</sup> in each class – 15% of entries for that class; 4<sup>th</sup> in class – 10% of entries for that class

(25% to be retained by the Club)

### Junior Handling

A special Junior Handling Competition will be held in conjunction with the Specialty. Junior Show Handling rules apply. All dogs handled must be entered in the Specialty Show in one of the official classes or for Exhibition Only. There is no Pee Wee class.

### Non-Regular Classes & Awards

#### Baby Puppy Class

The Baby Puppy Class is for dogs 3 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy Class do not compete for points.

Puppies entered in this class will participate & compete for Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Specialty. There is no listing fee for unregistered baby puppies.

#### Brace

NOWDA is pleased to offer the non-regular class of **BRACE**. Judging will take place immediately after breed and group judging. Dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed. A Brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead. **NB: Effective Jan 1, 2006, Ownership does NOT have to be identical!!!!!!**

#### Bred By Exhibitor

A trophy & rosette is offered for Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog in Specialty. Dogs must be entered in the BBE class, and handled by the breeder/owner at all levels of the competition....1st place male and female in the BBE class shall compete for Best Bred By in Breed and go on to compete for Best Bred By Exhibitor dog in Specialty.
