### DIRECTIONS TO HERDING EVENT

#### **FROM TORONTO**

Take QEW Fort Erie thru Niagara Falls. After McLeod Rd. the next exit is Lyons Creek Road, take the West exit (go right) onto Lyons Creek Rd.

Just as you are speeding up, there is a road on your left, (in other words make a right and then a quick left) onto Willodell Road. You are almost there! Go down Willodell Rd. approximately 2 miles. After you cross over Schisler Rd. (still on Willodell), we are the second place on the right.

There is a large cover-all building up on the hill.

Take the 2nd driveway or last driveway past the house, going back to the training center.

#### **FROM BUFFALO**

Take the QEW Niagara from the Peace Bridge. Take the Lyons Creek exit off of QEW.

At the stop sign, turn left onto Lyons Creek Rd. Just over the overpass there is a road on your left. This is Willodell Rd. Turn LEFT onto Willodell. You are almost there! Go down Willodell Rd. approximately 2 miles. After you cross over Schisler Rd., (still on Willodell) we are the second place on your right.

Take the last driveway past the house and follow the driveway back to the training center.

**Do not mail** this form until you have entered **and** received confirmation that you have gotten into at least three events. There is no fee to enter for this award.

To qualify for this award, a dog must be entered in at least 3 of the following 5 events offered at the CSSA National Show (Conformation, Obedience, Agility and Rally Obedience). Note: Herding instinct tests are not included in this award and will not be awarded a participation point.

**ADVANCED REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. Entries close (and must be received by Thursday, May 3, 2012.**

Point values will be assigned to entrants in competition as follows:

**BREED**

- 1 pt** Participation
- 2 pts** Make a Cut
- 3 pts** Place 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> in a class
- 4 pts** Reserve Winners, Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Award of Merit

Dogs receiving qualifying scores in performance events will be awarded 2, 3 or 4 points as appropriate for their class, but do not receive the participation point as well. The participation point in performance events is awarded only if the dog competes but does not qualify in the event. Dogs competing in multiple classes **in the same trial** will be credited with the highest placement received in any one class only.

**OBEDIENCE & RALLY**

- 1 pt** Participation
- 2 pts** Qualifying Score in Novice/Rally Novice
- 3 pts** Qualifying Score in Open/Advanced
- 4 pts** Qualifying Score in Utility/Excellent

Dogs who make a cut or earn placements and awards in Breed competition will be awarded 2, 3 or 4 points as applicable to the award, but do not receive the participation point as well. Dogs who make multiple cuts in a class will receive the same two points as dogs who make one cut. Dogs excused from the breed ring shall still receive a point for participation. Dogs disqualified from the ring shall not be awarded a point for participation.

**AGILITY TRIAL**

- 1 pt** Participation
- 2 pts** Qualifying Score in Novice
- 3 pts** Qualifying Score in Advanced
- 4 pts** Qualifying Score in Excellent

In the event of a tie, event scores shall be used to break the tie. (i.e. the most 4 pts, the most 3 pts. etc.). The dog with the highest total score will receive the award.

**HERDING**

- 1 pt** Participation
- 2 pts** Herding Tested/Herding Started
- 3 pts** Qualifying Intermediate Score
- 4 pts** Qualifying Advanced Score

The official catalog markings taken from the judge's book for each event shall be used to determine eligibility, participation, placements and official scores.

**BONUS: 1 point for a dog who competes in all five venues.**

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Canadian Shetland Sheepdog Association – 2012 National will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons or their possessions, or the contents of grooming areas or commercial booths. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible.
- Dogs not entered in the show will not be permitted in the Specialty Show area. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are at the show site. Dogs must be kept on leash **at all times**, except while competing in obedience, rally obedience, agility and/or herding. **In no case may a dog under six months of age be allowed within the precincts of the show/trial, including grooming areas during show hours.**
- All grooming must be done in designated grooming areas. **Crates and grooming tables will not be permitted at ringside. Dogs must not be bathed in the hotel guest rooms.** Dogs left unattended in hotel rooms must be crated at all times. There is to be no breeding of dogs in the show area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog before taking it to the judging ring. **Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only.**
- A judge shall have the right to measure in the ring and weigh or have weighed by the Superintendent, any dog whose breed standard lists height or weight as a disqualification. The decision of the Show Superintendent reported to the judge shall be final in the determination of the weight. The decision of the judge shall be final in the determination of all disqualifications. (Conformation Show Rules and Regulations, Section 4.6.1).
- Any dog excused by the Judge, Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show and/or trial.
- Judging to commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule.
- The Show precincts shall consist of all judging areas set aside for the show officials, judges, exhibitors and handlers and thirty (30) feet outside of the rings.

**NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

Effective January 1, 2012:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

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## OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASSES FOR SHETLAND SHEEPDOGS ONLY

Dogs in obedience must wear a well-fitted plain buckle or slip collar. Slip collars of any appropriate single length of leather, fabric or chain with two rings, one at each end, are acceptable. There shall be nothing hanging from the collar. There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog may be entered as a 'listed dog,' except that a dog which has obtained three qualifying scores at obedience trials held under CKC rules, may not continue to compete at licensed obedience trials held under CKC Rules until the dog is registered individually or obtained an ERN number with the CKC or until its owner has provided evidence satisfactory to the CKC that it is eligible for registration in the Club's records.

### OFFICIAL CLASSES

**Pre-Novice** – shall be for dogs which have not earned the title of C.D. or P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in Group Exercise.

**Novice A** – shall be for dogs which have not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Handler must be owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

**Novice B** – dogs may be handled by owner or any other person. If an exhibitor enters more than one dog, each dog must have a separate handler for the Group Exercises.

**Novice C** – is for dogs that have earned the title C.D., C.D.X., U.D. or any Obedience Trial Championship prior to the closing date of the trial. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Group Exercises. Scores earned by dogs in this class are not eligible for High In Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.

**Novice Intermediate Class** – shall be for dogs that have earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D. or any Obedience Trial Championship. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs may be handled by the owner or any other person. Scores earned by dogs in this class are not eligible for High In Trial.

**Open A** – shall be for dogs which have earned their C.D. but not the title of C.D.X. Only one dog per handler is allowed and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Handler must be owner or a member of their immediate families. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class. A dog which has earned its C.D.X. may be entered in the Open B class.

**Open B** – shall be for dogs which have earned their C.D., C.D.X. or U.D. title. Dogs may be handled by owner or any other person. If an exhibitor enters more than one dog, each dog must have a separate handler for the Group Exercises.

**Utility A** – shall be for dogs which have earned their C.D.X. but not the title of U.D. Handler must be owner or a member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. A person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class.

**Utility B** – shall be for dogs which have earned their C.D.X. or U.D. title. Handler must be owner or any other member. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

### UNOFFICIAL CLASSES (dogs must be entered in an Official Class or Exhibition Only)

**Graduate Novice** – open to any dog that has not earned a qualifying score toward a C.D.X. title in Canada, but has obtained the title of C.D. in Canada prior to closing date of trial. The owner or any other person may handle the dog. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog but have a separate handler for the Group Exercises when judged in the same group. Graduate Novice exercises will be performed and judged as in the official Novice class except for the Heel Free with Figure 8, Drop on Recall, Long Sit and Long Down will be performed and judged as in the official Open class.

**Graduate Open** – open to any dog that has not earned a qualifying score toward a U.D. title in Canada, but has obtained the title of C.D.X. in Canada prior to closing date of trial. The owner or any other person may handle the dog. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog but have a separate handler for the Group Exercises when judged in the same group.

**Brace** – Open to any 2 Shetland Sheepdogs that have earned a C.D. or higher title. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs. Owner or any other person may handle dogs. The Brace class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice class. The 2 dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on performance of the 2 dogs as though they were one. Exhibitors may enter more than one Brace but must have a separate handler for each brace in the Group Exercises.

**Team** – Open to any 4 Shetland Sheepdogs that have earned a C.D. or higher title and 4 handlers. It is not necessary that the same person own all dogs. Owner or any other person may handle dogs. Judgement will be based on performance of dogs and handlers plus team precision and co-ordination, using Novice exercises.

**Veterans** – shall be for dogs that have earned a C.D. title or higher and are 7 years or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice class. Dogs entered in the Veterans class must also be entered in any Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class but had a separate handler for the Group Exercises.

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## VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes are open to all dogs over 7 years of age. **Classes will be divided by sex as follows:**

- 7 years up to but not including 10 years
- 10 years up to but not including 13 years
- 13 years and over

All first place winners will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Runner Up in Veteran Sweepstakes.

A Rosette will be awarded to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes, Runner Up in Veteran Sweepstakes and First through Fourth in each class.

### *The cash awards will be divided in the following manner:*

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes	7% of all entry fees received
Runner Up in Veteran Sweepstakes	3% of all entry fees received

First in each class	25% of entry fees in that class
Second in each class	20% of entry fees in that class
Third in each class	15% of entry fees in that class
Fourth in each class	10% of entry fees in that class.

CSSA 2012 National will retain 20% of the total sweepstake entry fees for administration.

**All dogs entering Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the Official Classes or Exhibition Only at this specialty. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.**

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## BREEDER SWEEPSTAKES

**Class Structure (Age Requirements)**

1. **PEE WEE**  
4 years of age up to 6 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year. Optional and non-competitive. No placements are to be awarded, participant ribbons, rosettes and token trophies may be presented.
- 2A. **JUNIOR NOVICE**  
For handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.
- 2B. **JUNIOR OPEN**  
For handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won six first places with competition in the Junior Novice Class, OR any handler wishing to enter this level. It is understood that once that handler has entered and competed in the Open Class, he/she may not compete in the Novice Class again.
- 3A. **INTERMEDIATE NOVICE CLASS**  
For handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition.
- 3B. **INTERMEDIATE OPEN CLASS**  
For handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won six first places in the same class with competition.
- 4A. **SENIOR NOVICE CLASS**  
For handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won six first places in the same class with competition. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.
- 4B. **SENIOR OPEN CLASS**  
For handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won six first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he/she has enough experience to compete at this level.
5. **BEST OVERALL**

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Registration will be at the Show Secretary's table and must be done at least one hour in advance of the scheduled judging time.

A Prize and Rosette will be offered for Best Overall Conformation Junior Handler. Rosettes will be offered for First through Fourth place in each competitive class. Participant Ribbons will be offered for all Pee-Wees. There will be a special prize to all entrants.

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## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS



Chapter 15, Subsection 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Subsection 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points. To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Subsection 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

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## MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS



Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

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## CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS



The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Chapter 4 - Subsection 4.7.1** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

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## EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)



Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog plus applicable taxes.

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## DOG SHOW CLASSES FOR SHETLAND SHEEPDOGS ONLY



### OFFICIAL CLASSES (*divided by sex*)

**JUNIOR PUPPY** – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on the day of show.

**SENIOR PUPPY** – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on the day of show.

**12-18 MONTH** – a dog between 12 months and under 18 months on the day of show.

**CANADIAN BRED** – a dog which is born in Canada.


**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** – a dog owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

**OPEN CLASS** – for all dogs. **Divided into Open (Sable), Open (Black) and Open (Blue).**

**VETERANS CLASS** – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show (split 7 to 10 years and 10+ years). These dogs to compete for the regular placements, and the First place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

**SPECIALS ONLY** – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

**AWARD OF MERIT** – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.



### NON-REGULAR CLASSES (*dogs must be entered in an Official Class or Exhibition Only*)

**BRACE** – Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex. Ownership in this class need not be identical. Must be handled by one person on one lead.

**STUD DOG & Get** – Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

**BROOD BITCH & Progeny** – Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny. Brood bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

**EXHIBITION ONLY** – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.



### SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Limited to male and female dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. Classes will be judged after the judging of the Best of Breed.



### UNOFFICIAL CLASSES (*dogs must be entered in an Official Class or Exhibition Only*)

**PARADE OF CHAMPIONS** – This is a non-competitive class, open to all Shetland Sheepdogs. Dogs must have completed all requirements for a CKC championship.

**PARADE OF TITLEHOLDERS** – This is a non-competitive class, open to all Shetland Sheepdogs with a CKC recognized Conformation or Obedience title.

**PARADE OF VETERANS** – any Shetland Sheepdog who is seven years of age or over on the date of the show may enter the Parade of Veterans. Dogs entered in Parades must be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered dogs or dogs in unorthodox trim may be entered in a Parade. A monogrammed Rosette will be presented to each dog entered in these parades. **Clearly print the dog's name on the entry form.** Owners may submit a write-up of their dog's accomplishments at the time of entry. Limit 100 words. Please send along your dog's call name.

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## PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN)



PEN entries are accepted for performance events. U.S. Exhibitor's dogs who have an ILP are eligible for a PEN. To obtain a PEN the dog must meet the following conditions:

- be of a CKC recognized breed
- be unregistrable
- proof of being spayed or neutered
- not on a miscellaneous class list
- in case of a foreign dog it must have an AKC ILP

### Applying for a PEN:

Complete the CKC PEN application (available through CKC website). Submit either an AKC ILP certificate OR

- Submit two recent and clear photos of the dog in a standing position, one frontal view and one full profile. The photos must be signed by a Veterinarian confirming the breed size of the dog i.e. 20" Australian Cattle Dog
- A veterinary certificate confirming the dog has been spayed or neutered
- The dog must be identified with a CKC approved microchip: this requirement is not necessary for ILP dogs
- If the dog is co-owned, all co-owners must sign the application
- A statement as to why the dog cannot be properly registered with CKC
- Include the appropriate fee as noted in the CKC fee schedule
- Submit this material to the Canadian Kennel Club.

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## AGILITY TRIAL CLASSES



**Selected Class:** Any dog eligible to enter an agility trial may enter the Selected Class but can not be entered in the Selected Class and Regular Class at the same set of trials. Dogs entering the Selected Class must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice level. Dogs will jump one jump height lower than its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time than the Regular Standard course time.

**Novice A** is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.

**Novice B** is for agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

**Excellent A** is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in either Standard or JWW.

**Excellent B** is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent Title. A dog may move up into Excellent B in only the Standard or JWW class that they have earned an Excellent Title in. A dog only needs to be entered in Excellent B for the class that he/she has achieved the excellent title in. *ie. A dog can be in Excellent A JWW and Excellent B Standard.*

**Veteran Class:** a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Dogs will jump one or two jump heights lower than its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time than the Regular Standard course time.
