2 FIELD DOG JUNIOR TESTS FOR POINTING BREEDS

Tests held under CKC Rules
For All CKC Recognized Pointing Breeds

DATE: Saturday, September 19, 2020

LOCATION: Featherquest Farms, Delburne, AB

START TIME: To be determined once entries close. We will be running Field Dog Junior tests in the morning and the afternoon. Each is a separate event which will allow participants the opportunity to get up to 2 FDJ legs in a single day.

ENTRIES: Only mail or email entries will be accepted. No phone entries. Entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be successfully run during reasonable daylight hours (max 12 dogs per test).

Day of Entries: There will be NO Day of Entries accepted.

Entry Fees: \$60.00 per test (payable via cash, e-transfer to the email address listed below or by cheque. Cheques made out to: GSPCC). **Fees are payable in Canadian funds.**

ENTRIES OPEN on SEPTEMBER 8, 2020 at 8 a.m.
ENTRIES CLOSE at 5 p.m. on Wednesday September 16, 2020
DRAWING at 8 p.m. on Wednesday September 16, 2020

- Entries may close prior to 5:00 pm September 16, if full
- Entries withdrawn after closing must still pay the appropriate fees, failure to do so, will be considered “*outstanding*” payment
- Running order draw will take place at the home of the Test Secretary and will be available after drawing. All entrants will be sent a running order and directions to the test site.
- The drawing will be random, and specific times cannot be assigned
- It is the responsibility of entrants to confirm receipt of their entries
- Signed waivers and entry fees must be in the hands of the test secretary before your dog will be allowed to run.

NOTE: Bitches in season will be run only in the afternoon test, after all other dogs have completed their run. If your bitch comes into season, please inform the secretary to be moved to the end of the day.

COURSE & GAME:

- Chukar/Pheasant or Quail may be used.
- Handlers must carry a starter pistol.

OTHER RULES:

- No training of dogs on the grounds during the tests
- Qualifying scores available at the end of each test from the Test Secretary
- COVID 19 municipal and provincial guidelines are in effect. Please social distance, wear masks when needed, use hand sanitizer and be kind to your fellow attendees.
- There will be no overnight camping and there will be no concession provided. Please have enough food and water for you and for your dogs.

AWARDS: Standard CKC Blue Ribbon to all dogs with a qualifying score.

NOTE: FIELD DOG TEST RULES & REGULATIONS para. 18.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Dog Test is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Committee Chairman shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

NOTE: NEW Para 11.3

It is mandatory that judges, handlers of the working dogs and marshals wear a blaze orange outer garment (vest or jacket) and blaze orange head gear in any tests where shotguns are used. The requirements will also apply to any gallery members on the course.

TCN (Temporary Competition Number) A TCN Fee of \$10.50 (per day) must accompany the entry if a CKC INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION NUMBER, ERN or PEN NUMBER does not appear on the entry form. TCN fee is payable with the entry fee if the dog has a CKC Temporary Competitive Number. * effective March 2nd, any dog that does not have a registration number must apply for a TCN number from CKC

The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of Canada nor the landowners will not be held liable for damage or loss to any person, dog or property. Please keep your area clean.

AGREEMENT OF EACH ENTRANT

In consideration of the acceptance of my/our entry(ies) and of the holding of the test and of the opportunity to have the dog tested and to win ribbons or trophies, I/we acknowledge and agree as follows:

The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of Canada (GSPCC) may refuse any entry for just cause, which the GSPCC deems to be sufficient.

Field tests have certain inherent dangers associated with them, including, without limitation, those due to the presence and/or use of firearms, and as such any person participating in the test or being present on the test grounds assumes the associated risks.

To hold the Canadian Kennel Club (the "CKC"), any CKC approved judge, the GSPCC, its members, directors, officers, agents, committee members, test secretary, official gunners at the test and the owners or lessor of the test grounds and any employees of any of them (collectively, the "Club"), harmless from:

Any claim for loss or injury which may be caused or alleged to be caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by any act of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, while in or upon the test grounds, or near any entrance to the test grounds;

Any claim for loss of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether the loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury is caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any other person or any other cause or causes;

For bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting from bodily injuries, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves, any minors for whom I/we is or are responsible or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my/our or their participation in the test or presence on the test grounds, however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Club or any of them or any other person; and

I/we personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I/we further agree to assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the Club harmless from any and all losses and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law or a court of competent jurisdiction upon the Club or any of them for any of the foregoing.

I/we agree to be bound by this Agreement of Each Entrant printed in the Official Premium List. I/we certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs.
