

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers and agents please note that the full name and address of all owners must be completed. Incomplete entries will be returned. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
2. Receipts and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after closing.
3. Telephone and telegraph entries are prohibited and will not be accepted, except in the case of a postal strike.
4. The Show Superintendent shall be in full charge of the show.
5. Entry of a dog cannot be canceled after entries have closed.
6. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick or excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or because he is entered incorrectly.
7. The Portage Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
8. If because of riot, civil disturbance or any acts beyond the control of the Portage Kennel Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.
9. All dogs must be kept under control at all times. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to clean up after their dog in all arena areas outside. An exercise area will be provided for dogs and it is expected that this area will be used.
10. Dogs should be in the show building one hour prior to judging of their breed. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when it is required for judging. Handlers are requested to report any absentees and have assistants at ringside if they are engaged elsewhere. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.
11. The building will be open from approximately 3 -10:30 pm the evening prior to the first show. It will open at 7:00 am and close at 10:30 pm each day of the show. Exhibitors leaving dogs in the building do so at their own risk.

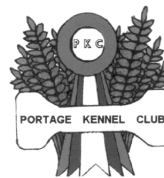

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) : Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all foreign born and foreign owned dogs that enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration #, but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Forms to apply for an ERN will be available at the show. Or simply send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, with a written request for an ERN number and a check for \$58.85 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials, 200 Ronson Dr., Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ontario. M9W 5Z9

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted checks will not be accepted.

Personal checks will be accepted, however, they are to be in **Canadian funds**. If you send a check in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark checks "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks and would constitute non payment of funds.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase BANK DRAFTS or MONEY ORDERS payable in CANADIAN FUNDS. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

15.1 Champions and Championship Points

15.1.1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 - 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials only, shall be included in the total.

15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- (c) Have earned at least one 2 point win, either at the breed or group level.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition as provided in Chapter 4, Section 8(j) of these Rules shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees however, WILL NOT be refunded

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS AND OBEDIENCE TRIALS. Rulebooks are available from CKC.

Obedience Classifications

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE “A” & “B” AT SAME TRIAL

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN “A” & “B” AT SAME TRIAL

PRE-NOVICE— This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. but must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE “A” - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of “CD” in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its “UD” title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE “B” CLASS**

NOVICE “B” - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of “CD”, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

NOVICE “C”— This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice ‘C’ exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice ‘C’ Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice ‘C’ Class are not eligible for High In Trial.

The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice ‘C’ are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice ‘C’ class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open Class. This class shall be for any dog of any recognized breed or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or higher title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

OPEN CLASSES There are four (4) Open classes: The Open HA and Open HB classes, which include the Out of Sight Group Stay Exercises and the Open 18A and Open 18B classes, which include the Change of Positions and Group Sit - Walk Around exercises.

OPEN “HA” & “18A” - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of “CD” IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of “CDX” in any country. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its “UD” title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN “HB” & “18B” - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of “CD” IN CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS ‘A’ - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of “CDX” but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS ‘B’ - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of “CDX” or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside approx. 30 minutes prior to the start of the class.

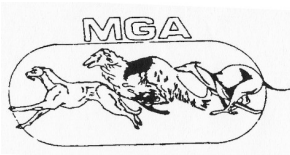

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be offered at this Specialty:
6-9 months; 9-12 months; 12-15 months; 15-18 months; Canadian Bred; Bred By Exhibitor; Open; Veteran; Specials Only.

Veteran's Class: shall be divided into 2 classes: 7 to 10 years and 10 years of age and over. Dogs in this class do not compete for points; the winner of each class goes directly on to compete at the Best of Breed level. They may also be spayed or neutered.

Baby Puppy: Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the date of the Specialty, Best Baby Male; Best Baby Female; Best Baby Puppy in Breed.

Sexually Altered Classes: Two classes only will be offered - Altered Male and Altered Female, winners of class will compete for Best Altered in Breed.

Non-Regular Classes: Brace, Stud Dog & Get, Brood Bitch & Progeny

Unofficial Classes: Award(s) of Merit (One Award of Merit per 10 dogs competing for the breed, at the judge's discretion. Rosettes and Certificates will be awarded.)

Herding Class: (Classes will be separated by sex, Open to any Corgi who has obtained a minimum of a HIC. Best Male and Best Female to be chosen, then the Best Male & Best Female will compete against each other for Best in Herding Class. Dogs are to be judges on their conformation according to breed std. Dogs may be altered.)
