

Nov 11th, 2024 Indoor Agility Trial Judging Schedule

Thank you for supporting our trial.

Course maps will be taped on the inside of the garage doors (maps for novice standard will be posted after the novice warm up run). No course maps will be handed out, please take a picture of the course map that is posted. You will be checking in and selecting your volunteer positions at the registration desk. Barb, our volunteer coordinator will be there to assist you. Your entry was dependant on your volunteering for at least 2 positions during the trial, without you we would be unable to run the trial.

You MUST have indoor shoes when you are in the Red Barn.

PARKING and CRATING: Parking is available in the main parking lot as well as on east and west side of Red Barn. You may NOT park along the laneway under the trees.

There is crating available in the Red Barn on a first come basis. The area on the SOUTH side of the ring is for <u>quiet dogs only</u>. If your dog barks or whines while you are helping in the ring, please crate in EAST crating area outside of rubber area. **The East area of the crating area is for dogs who whine or bark only. The Red Barn is excited to say there have been some renovations recently for a fitness pool. Crating is smaller now so those of you with dogs who are quiet please crate in the south area. Competitors may crate from their car, but we will not have anyone calling out for dogs in the parking lot so if you are crating there you are responsible for being at the ring on time.**

RESULTS & RIBBONS:

You will find the results posted on tables on the garage doors. You're qualifying and placement ribbons will be in the ribbon box, self serve. If you do not wish to take them that is okay. Congrats to those of you who achieved a new title and wish to get a new title ribbon. Please go to Barb at check in and purchase your new title ribbon for \$10 (please exact change only). Please send us a picture so we can post it on our social media ③ You will also receive an email of your results. Results will also be posted on The Red Barn Event Centre website.

We will have a leash runner. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash (this is a CKC regulation). There cannot be food or toys (non-squeaky toys are allowed in FFO runs) within 10 ft of the ring (this is a CKC regulation).

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- PLEASE drive slowly down the long driveway. 10 km limit!
- There is a private residence at the front of the property. Do not walk your dogs down the driveway towards the residence as it upsets the dogs who live there.
- Only Park in the designated parking area.
- Garbage policy at the Red Barn "IF YOU BRING IT, PLEASE TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU" There will be a
 garbage can for the dog poop outside the door but that is all that can be put into it. Please cleanup
 after your dog.
- No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum
- Be nice to our judges and volunteers. Remember if you want to be treated with respect give others the same respect. We have a zero tolerance for any abuse of dogs or humans.
- Agility is a team sport, so please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home. Remember
 we enter the ring as friends and leave the ring as friends.

In 2010 the Board of Directors of the CKC passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting, the Tracking fee motion was deleted and replaced with the following motion. Non-Member Participation Fee a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. This fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either, to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member Participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non- CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Cost is \$63.90 + HST.


CKC HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

• CRATING: The East area (on concrete) of the crating area is for dogs who whine or bark only. The Red Barn is excited to say there has been some renovations recently. Our main crating area has changed slightly, so those of you with dogs who are quiet please crate in the south area to ensure there is room for all who want to crate indoors.

Competitors may crate from their car Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under

control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is friendly.
