

**ENTRIES:** Entries must be complete, signed and submitted on the official CKC entry form. The order of competing shall be the order that entries are received.

#### SAME DAY MOVE UPS WILL BE ALLOWED as per Rule 6.7.1

**CLOSING DATE:** <u>30 minutes before the scheduled start of class</u> or when the stated limit has been reached. Online entries close at 9:00 pm September 19, 2019. Entries will close automatically when the following limits have been reached for each test on each day: 20 Introduction to Quarry, 25 Junior, 15 Senior and 10 Master even if the official closing date and time for the entries has not arrived. Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date and time. If the limit is reached prior to the closing date, a list of alternates will be kept to fill any vacancies created due to early (prior to closing date) cancellations.

**CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY:** The receipt of entries will be confirmed for those providing a **return e-mail address** on their entry form.

**BITCHES IN SEASON:** Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the test secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test must reach the secretary on or before the date of the test. The trial-giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

QUARRY: The guarry used in these tests will be 2 adult gerbils.

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. If you pay by personal American cheque, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Do not write "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". This will not be acceptable and will not be cleared by the bank. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

**BORDER CROSSING:** Government regulations require a valid rabies certificate for dogs entering Canada from countries not recognized by Canada as being rabies-free. The European Union pet passport is an acceptable alternative to the rabies vaccination certificate as long as all the elements outlined in the requirements are included. **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (FOREIGN BORN/FOREIGN OWNED DOG):** For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dog's foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee along with the completed application form.

**AWARDS & PRIZES:** Qualifiers in IQ will receive a Ribbon. Qualifiers in JE, SE and ME will receive a Rosette. Dogs earning a new title will be awarded a Pin. In celebration of our 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Test, all qualifiers and new title holders will be awarded a prize.

**TEST PRECINCT:** The entire field south of the buildings. Dogs waiting to be tested shall be kept at least 30.5 m (100ft) from the perimeter of the test area in a designated holding area.

**REGULATIONS:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Earthdog Test Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Tel: (416) 675-5511.

**CKC REGULATION 15.7:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an Earthdog Test held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**TEST SITE:** Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run **rain or shine**. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the test. Flexi leads will not be allowed within the test precinct. Remember that this is private property and we are here at the pleasure of our hosts. The test site is strictly non-smoking; if you must smoke please do so in your vehicle and dispose of your butts appropriately. Vehicle parking is limited, please obey all parking directions. On site portable washroom will be available. Clean up after yourself and your dog. As is the case with most Earthdog Tests, the ground at the site is uneven; wear appropriate footwear.

**WAIVER:** Please complete the enclosed waiver that excludes the property owners, the Performance and Earthdog Association of Alberta, and/or any person associated with the Earthdog Test from any liability for personal injury or personal property damage and submit it with your entry.

**LUNCHES:** Due to COVID-19 health recommendations on sharing food and serving utensils, there will NOT be a potluck lunch. Please bring your own food and drinks. Restaurants are at least 15 minutes away.

**Morning test:** Master Earthdog class will start no earlier than 9:00 AM. Introduction to Quarry will start no earlier than 9:30 AM.

#### CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

(This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member, nor does it affect US exhibitors who must apply for an ERN number as noted above)

A non-member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt. There are 2 options for non-members:

- a) Join the CKC, or
- b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs or titles or awards earned, and is assessed against the owner(s).

Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned. Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. Once cancellation takes place any subsequent awards titles, legs, etc. earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.

Please note that the CKC Membership application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website under CKC Services and then Forms On-Line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that CKC is aware of the dogs involved.



#### **Earthdog Test COVID-19 Information and Safety Measures**

These guidelines may be altered or amended before the test, as per current Alberta Chief Medical Officer recommendations

- Please familiarize yourself with the latest AHS screening checklist and refer to this
  document before attending the tests. If you exhibit any of the listed symptoms or
  have been in contact with anyone who has symptoms or has travelled recently,
  please advise us and we will refund your entry fees (less any processing costs).
- When arriving on site, all participants must proceed to the club house to check in.
  We will complete a secondary in-person screening questionnaire each day of the
  test. This is to address condition of new arrivals and any overnight symptom
  changes. This is a requirement prior to competing in the tests. Avoid overcrowding in this area during the check in process.
- Parking Please leave more space between vehicles, within reason. Be prepared
  to bench out of your vehicles while waiting your turn. Only handlers and dogs that
  are running will be permitted in the den area
- Practice physical distancing, where possible. Maintain physical distancing in the parking area on the west side of the driveway
- There will be designated areas for the gallery. Please maintain the 2 metres distance from anyone who is not in your household or social bubble. Don't be offended if someone reminds you to step back!
- There will be enhanced cleaning and disinfecting procedures in place during the
  weekend tests. Judges will have disinfecting wipes to clean the quarry ends
  between each handler and dog. High contact surfaces around the club house will
  be disinfected on a regular basis. Hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes and a hand
  wash station will be available to assist with maintaining hygiene.
- Spray disinfectant will be available at the porta potty. Anyone using this facility
  will be expected to spray down surfaces after each use to ensure this area remains
  as clean as possible.
- All judges, workers and handlers should use proper hand washing, be conscious
  of respiratory etiquette and avoid borrowing others equipment. The number of
  volunteer workers in the field and den areas will be limited to as few as possible.
- You are encouraged to wear a mask while on site; masks are our best line of defense against COVID-19. The wearing of masks will be mandatory for judges and handlers in the IQ den area and is strongly recommended at the JE, SE and ME den locations. The judges will ensure that they step well back while the handler is retrieving their dog from the quarry end. Please plan to bring your own masks; a limited supply of disposable masks will be available if you forget.
- While the test dog is running, be very conscious not to crowd the staging area.
   Please wait your turn and do not move to the staging area until the previous person is over 2 metres away.
- Please pick up after your dog, especially in any parking areas and along the driveway, and keep your dogs on leash. Be sure to pick up and take ALL your belongings at the end of the day; it is imperative that personal items not be left behind.
- As we are unable to provide hospitality, please bring a "brown bag" lunch and other refreshments.
