Non-member Participation Fees are in effect

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members

Listing fees are payable with the entry fee for dogs that do not have their Individual registration number at closing date. A litter registration is not acceptable. Official CKC entry forms must be used. Please photo copy the enclosed entry forms if you require more than were supplied. Personal cheque or Money order for the full amount only will be accepted and should be made out to **PICTOU COUNTY KENNEL CLUB.**

No post dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be Subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will

be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

Junior handling will be held Saturday in the first available ring. Dogs competing in junior handling must be entered in the show in one of the regular classes or in exhibition only.

General Information

The Pictou County Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of any accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.

Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.

The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.

Due to the limited amount of space, the superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the superintendent in this regard.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Conformation Show Rules Sec. 19.7)

Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted on the show premises.

Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.

Champions and championship points - chapter 15

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded winners also places in the group.

A class dog awarded best in show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and,
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number; and
- (c) have earned at least one 2 point win at either the breed or group level.
