IMPORTANT CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION

The Non-Member Participation fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is paid in the calendar year (January-December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)
- Scent Detection Levels offered Instinct, Novice (Containers, Interior and Exterior) Open (Containers, Interior, Exterior) and Excellent (Containers, Interior, Exterior). Exhibitors can compete in same level components with a maximum of two dogs.

• Mixed and unrecognized breeds will be accepted at this trial. These dogs must have a CCN (Canine Companion Number) issued by the Canadian Kennel Club in order to participate in these trials.

- **Bitches in season** bitches in season are not permitted to compete (See CKC Scent Detection Rule 6.5). We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate. The certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.
- Penalties issued by the club dropping food while rewarding is considered contamination. Contamination of the search area will result in a non-qualifying score and any dog that urinates or defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the competition. Handlers will be charged for any damage done to equipment by dogs (including urinating on items, excessive scratching or subsequent breaking of any item).
- **Reminder** that anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.
