## CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

*The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.*

12 - 18 Months	-A dog 12 months of age and under 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	-A dog which is born in Canada.
Bred by Exhibitor	-The handler must be the owner/co-owner <b>AND</b> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog further for awards.
Open Class	-For all dogs.
Specials Only	-Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number (ERN) and have attained the required points for Championship Status. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy in Breed if eligible.

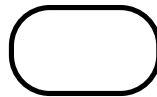

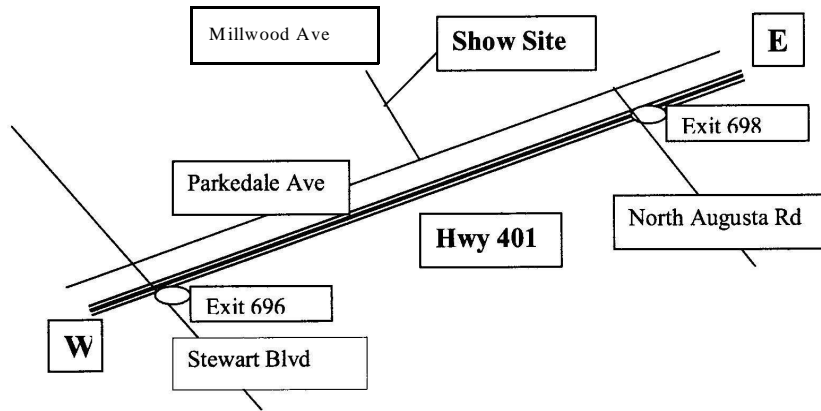


