OVER PAYMENTS WILL GRATEFULLY BE ACCEPTED AS A DONATION

- The entry of a dog at a trial must be accompanied by the entry fee. Conditional entries or entries accompanied by post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
- The club must reject an incomplete entry form and promptly return it to whoever submitted it, be it the owner, lessee, or authorized agent.
- Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. A collection fee of \$25 will be added to any returned cheque.
- CKC Rule 6.5.2 When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, she may be withdrawn from the trial and the trial-giving club must refund the entry fee and listing fee providing the Trial Secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial. **The DogShow.ca service fee will not be refunded.**

HIGH AGGREGATE OVER FOUR TRIALS, IN EACH GROUP (Sporting, Hound, Working Dog, Terrier, Toy, Non-Sporting, Herding) - To be awarded to the dog and handler who achieves the highest combined qualifying scores from four trials. Qualifying scores must be from the same class and the dog must be entered and handled by the same handler, in all four trials. The dog does not have to qualify in all four trials entered but must have the highest aggregate score in the Group. In the event of a tie, a runoff will be judged by Sunday Obedience Judge. – Appropriate Prize – Donated Anonymously

RALLY PRIZES

For Each Rally Trial:

Rally High Combined Prize - High Combined Rally will be awarded as follows: the eligible dog must be entered in either Advanced B and Excellent B or Excellent B and Master. Dogs entered in triples (Advanced B, Excellent B and Master) will drop their lowest score. Only two scores will be considered. The highest combined score from the two classes will be awarded High Combined – Donated by NKC

A rosette and prize will be awarded to the **Highest Qualifying Score with the Fastest time earned in each class** – Donated Anonymously

RULES GOVERNING THESE OBEDIENCE TRIALS

Rules & Regulations: It is the responsibility of each competitor to be familiar with and abide by the Canadian Kennel Club Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2021, including the possible rule changes due to Covid-19. Both can be found on the CKC website, WWW.CKC.ca https://www.ckc.ca/en/Files/Forms/Shows-Trials/Event-Rules-Regulations/Obedience-Trial-and-Rally-Obedience-Trial-Rules-an

Discipline: The Nanaimo Kennel Club reserves the right to remove any person from these trials and entry fees may be forfeited. The Trial Chair shall have full control of this event which will be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club rules.

Indignities - Rule 20.7 - It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

No entry fee will be refunded if these trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Change of Entry: A dog may be moved from one official class to another within the same trial. A dog that has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules, may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the Trial Secretary on the appropriate form by the owner or handler AT LEAST THIRTY MINUTES PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TRIAL.

Eligibility to enter specific obedience and rally classes is detailed in the Obedience Trial & Rally Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations. Entrants should review these requirements before entering the trials to ensure they are entered in the correct class. Nanaimo Kennel Club will not be held responsible for incorrect entries. The owner of a dog entered in these trials is entirely responsible for any error in entering their dog (s), regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Entry forms which are incomplete or those which contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the win(s) being cancelled and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action

The Trials Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, loss or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during these Trials

Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct and actions of their animals while they are on the Trials grounds. All dogs must be kept under control and on leash except for off leash exercises in the obedience ring

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Dogs are to be exercised in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY

Any dog excused by the Trials Chair or a Veterinarian for any reason, shall not compete in any class for any award for the balance of these Trials

Rule 20.6 - Any person, either within or outside the judging ring, who does anything calculated to attract, distract or otherwise interfere in any way with the attention, deportment or performance of a dog under judgment may be disciplined by the Discipline Committee in whatever way it considers to be in the best interest of the club, or the judge may take summary action.

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event).
- 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the even on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.


The NKC has the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

ATTENTION US - FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - Please enter via DogShow.ca to avoid the difficulty in having to get a bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds.

Current exchange rates favor the US dollar. To take advantage of this, US exhibitors, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds for the full amount of the entry. No personal cheques payable in US dollars or marked payable in "Canadian Funds" or "at par" will be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted but must be payable in US FUNDS for the full amount of the entry.

Please ensure that your dog has an ERN (event Registration number). For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC titles and degrees, foreign born, foreign owned dogs may apply for an event registration number. This number must be obtained within 30 days of the first show entered to avoid cancellation of titles or legs earned and can be obtained by submitting a copy of your foreign certificate of registration along with a fee and a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN replaces a CKC individual registration number for show entering purposes only. For breeding purposes, the individual registration number must still be obtained.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee: Canadian Resident non-CKC members competing with a wholly owned dog cannot win an award or title unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Additional day parking is available across the road from the Centennial Building. The area in front of the building is for loading and unloading only, other than handicapped parking and parking for officials.

The City of Nanaimo has leash and poop-scoop bylaws. Please keep your dogs on leash, at all times and clean up after them.

The building will be open November 12 and 13 from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. All exercise pens must have plastic sheeting under them. Absolutely no smoking is allowed in the building. There are no designated smoking areas within Beban Park. Please clean up your area before you leave. Lock your vehicles and watch your belongings. Dogs and equipment are left at the exhibitor's own risk. The Nanaimo Kennel Club will not accept responsibility for lost or damaged items.
