All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full, and all listing fees (\$10.50 including GST) where applicable. A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number is not shown on the entry form or ERN notice. Scratches will be refunded for a bitch totally in season. All other scratches will be refunded at the hunt test committee's discretion, other than a fee of \$15.00.

TEST GROUNDS: These grounds are private property. The landowner has generously allowed us to hold our event on their property, so we ask that you respect the grounds. Drive and park as directed while on the land. Clean up after yourself and your dogs. No training on the grounds before, during or after the event. The landowners will not be approached for private training.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION:

By entering this Test (as handler, spectator or in any other capacity) each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to these Tests and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club and its members, any volunteer and the owner(s) and/or lease(s) of any property upon which the Test may be held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

Any person participating in any capacity at a Hunt Test or Working Certificate Test held under the CKC rules and regulations shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the tests and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. On report to the Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club of an alleged indignity of any kind the Test Chairman will report the infringement to the CKC and the Test Committee shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall have the power to take action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.

Rule 20.7 of the Hunt Test Rules and Regulations states: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject any indignities.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. Hard copies of the Hunt Test Rules and Regulations re available from the Canadian Kennel Club, suite 400, 200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke, On M9W 5Z9. Or you can download one from the CKC website.
- 2. Entries must be typewritten or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. The Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form. Make cheques payable to Wild Rose Hunting Retriever Club.
- **3.** A separate Entry Form for each dog in each test is required (official CKC Entry Form).
- **4.** Entry fees will not be refunded **after 7:00 PM June 17, 2019**. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or if it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refunds of entry will be made.
- 5. In the event of a mail strike, please courier, complete online, or hand deliver entries, to the Test Secretary prior to the closing date.
- **6.** No post-dated cheques will be accepted.
- **7.** Post entries will not be accepted.
- 8. Running order will be determined by random selection. Running order and the catalogue will be posted on Canuck Dogs no later than 6:00 PM on July 2nd, 2019. There will be no catalogues printed and distributed this year, but a running order will be available the morning of the test.
- 9. Bitches in season shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the test grounds.
- **10.** Ducks and pheasants may be used in all stakes. Pigeons may be used for the upland hunting test in the Master Hunt Tests. Wingers may be used in any stake.
- 11. All throwers, Judges and competitors should wear dark or camouflaged clothing.
- 12. Any dog not appearing within 15 minutes of being called to the line by the Marshall may be disqualified.
- **13.** All exhibitors are responsible for their own meals.
- 14. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the test to qualify for a refund. All other refunds must be requested in writing within 14 days of the event, explaining the reason for the scratch. Scratches will be refunded at the discretion of the Hunt Test Committee, all but a fee of \$15.00.
- **15.** Effective Jan. 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). Each dog mush have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, send a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheques or

- VISA/MasterCard number. Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. Cost \$62.40 (including GST) ERN numbers must be applied for within 30 days of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.
- **16.** The Wild Rose Hunting Club and its members will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for , nor assume any liability in the event of an accident, injury or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 17. Electric Collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worm by any dog on the test grounds at any time during the event.
- **18.** There shall be no training of dogs on the test grounds, except for single training bumpers, which are thrown by hand by the trainer, within 24 hours of the commencement of the event or an anytime during the event.
- **19.** All qualifying dogs will receive a rosette.

NOTIC TO ALL CANADIAN RESIDENTS

NEW CKC RULE

Section 24-12-3 NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

- A) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of the CKC.
- B) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and title to be cancelled.
