Saturday, Sept 1st: Trial 3 = 1 STD, 1 JWW, 1 PAD (Points and Distance) – Billie Mclean  
Trial 4 = 1 Steeplechase, 1 JWW, 1 STD – Francine LaLonde

Sunday, Sept 2nd : Trial 5 = 1 STD, 1 JWW – Francine LaLonde  
Trial 6 = 1 STD – Francine LaLonde

## Entries

Entries will be accepted ONLINE ONLY and from THE AGILITY ROCKS ONLINE ENTRY PROGRAM ONLY at <http://www.agilityrocks.com>. THIS IS **NOT** “**THE ENTRY LINE LTD**”. Confirmations will be emailed after the entry deadline.

When using the Agility Rocks online entry you will be required to create a username and password and enter your information and your dog(s) information just as would normally be required on the entry form. Select the trial that you are entering (HKC Agility) and then click the waiver page and then enter. As the only option for payment for the HKC trials is by cheque you are required to print the confirmation of your entry and send it by mail with a cheque to the Trial Secretary by the date listed in your confirmation. If you have any questions please contact the Trial Secretary.

No entry will be accepted that is incomplete or that is submitted without full entry fees. Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dog(s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The HKC reserves the right to refuse an entry, subject to CKC rules.

Listing fees: A CKC listing fee of \$11.50 Can or US per trial is payable with the entry for dogs that do not have their individual CKC Registration Number, PEN, ERN, MCN, or CCN.

Tendering of a NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC Rule 13.7.2). Charges for any NSF cheques issued to the HKC will be \$20.00. No post-dated cheques will be accepted. Overpayment of entry fees less than \$10.00 will not be refunded.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

## Eligibility

To compete in these trails, a dog must be at least 18 months of age and registered with the CKC and have a registration number, or an ERN, PEN, CCN or Misc. certificate number, or be eligible for the same. Dogs may not be lame.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a refund of the entry fee will be made as long as a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, reaches the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial.

Entries may be refunded for dogs/bitches that pose a threat of communicable diseases on the day of the trial provided a letter stating such is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of the trial.

## **NON-PUREBRED DOGS REQUIRE A CCN TO COMPLETE THEIR ENTRY:**

These trials are open to non-purebred dogs. If entering your non-purebred dog (includes mixed-breed and unrecognized-breed) in these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number to complete the entry form. Please check the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.34 (found on-line at the CKC website <http://www.ckc.ca/en/Events/Overview-of-Events/Agility>) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN. ## **Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice:**

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC by phone at (416) 675-5511 or by fax (416) 675-6506.

## **Non-Member Participation Fee (Canadian residents):**

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non-member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

## **Parking**

There is ample parking at the Sportsplex. For those traveling with a motor home or RV and wish to park at the site there will be a designated area for them but there are no hookups available. You must be self contained.

## **Trial and General Information:**

1. Ribbons: Rosettes will be awarded for Qualifying Scores and flat ribbons for 1st -4th placement in each class. Rosettes will be awarded for HIT.
2. Move ups are available to the next class between days or one hour before the start of the next trial on the same day by completing the required Move-up Form.
3. Participants in the trials will be required to volunteer. A volunteer sign up sheet will be sent out once entries close.
4. Timing will be manual. Electronic timer is not being used.
5. Venue: 100' x 100' Enclosed Ring ~ Indoors ~ On artificial turf, Indoor crating area will be available.

6. Trial Precincts: Indoors - the area includes the agility ring and the area of the building designated by the Trial Committee for indoor crating and areas designated for the use of the Trial Secretary, Judge and Committee.
7. No equipment familiarization will be offered for Novice dogs.
8. Warm-up jumps will be provided in proximity to the ring area
