#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers and agents please note that the full name and address of all owners must be completed. Incomplete entries will be returned. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 2. Receipts and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after closing.
- 3. Telephone and telegraph entries are prohibited and will not be accepted, except in the case of a postal strike.
- 4. The Show Superintendent shall be in full charge of the show.
- 5. Entry of a dog cannot be canceled after entries have closed.
- 6. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick or excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or because he is entered incorrectly.
- 7. The Portage Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 8. If because of riot, civil disturbance or any acts beyond the control of the Portage Kennel Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.
- 9. All dogs must be kept under control at all times. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to clean up after their dog in all arena areas outside. An exercise area will be provided for dogs and it is expected that this area will be used.
- 10. Dogs should be in the show building one hour prior to judging of their breed. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when it is required for judging. Handlers are requested to report any absentees and have assistants at ringside if they are engaged elsewhere. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.
- 11. The building will be open from approximately 6-10:30 pm the evening prior to the first show. It will open at 7:00 am and close at 10:30 pm each day of the show. Exhibitors leaving dogs in the building do so at their own risk.

#### 15.1 Champions and Championship Points

- **15.1.1.** A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.
- **15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

- **15.1.3** If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing is the bred, including Specials only, shall be included in the total.
- **15.1.4** If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- **15.1.6** If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.
- **15.1.7** The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determines by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.
- **15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:
- (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and
- (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN)
- (c) Have earned at least one 2 point win, either at the breed or group level.
- **15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition as provided in Chapter 4, Section 8(j) of these Rules shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

#### MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration BEFORE the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a LISTED dog. Listing fees however, WILL NOT be refunded

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)
