**NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

### SPECIALTY CONFORMATION SHOW

#### REGULAR CLASSES:

The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months	Bred by Exhibitor	
Canadian Bred	Open	Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

#### **Note:**

Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed.

This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

**Baby Puppy Class** - Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non regular class.

**Brace Class** - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed

**Stud Dog Class** - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

**Brood Bitch Class** - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

**Note:** All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

### CONFORMATION CLASSES

The official CKC classes, divided by sex, will be provided. Enter one category only.

**Junior puppy** - a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.

**Senior puppy** - a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show

**12-18 months** - a dog between 12 months up to 18 months on the day of show

**Canadian bred** - a dog which was born in Canada.

**Bred by exhibitor** - a dog owned and handled by the breeder

**Open class** - all dogs

**Veterans** - all dogs 7 years of age or older. Dogs may be neutered.

**Specials only** - dogs who are Canadian champions only

**Exhibition** - dogs 6 months and over, not in competition

**Altered** - dogs 6 months & over that have been sexually altered

### ALL BREED OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A & B, Open HA & HB, Open 18A & 18B, Utility A & B (Pre-Novice, Novice C and Novice Intermediate)

SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED State Jump Heights

### ALL BREED RALLY CLASSES:

Novice A & B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Master.

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG

SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG

Entry to be made at the show. A prize and rosette will be awarded for Best Overall Junior Handler and for 1st in each class.

THE PETER LIEBSCH MEMORIAL TROPHY – IS OFFERED TO THE BEST PUPPY IN SPECIALTY WINNER

THE BETH MEAD MEMORIAL TROPHY – IS OFFERED TO THE BEST BROOD BITCH IN SPECIALTY WINNER

THE BISS CH TRICOUNTYS DREAMLAND EXPRESS ROMX MEMORIAL TROPHY – IS OFFERED TO THE BEST VETERAN IN SPECIALTY WINNER

### **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES**

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 3 months up to but not including 18 months of age.

To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials or Exhibition Only..

There will be eight classes in all, divided by sex.

**3-6 mths** for dogs at least 3 months of age up to but not including 6 months.

**Junior Class** for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

**Senior Class** for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

**12-18 Open** for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

### **VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES**

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up.

To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only.

There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

**7-9 years** for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

**9-11 years** for Dogs 9 years of age up to but not including 11 years.

**11 years +** for Dogs 11 years of age and older

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

**CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS - CHAPTER 21**

**SECTION 1** - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**VEHICLE UNLOADING INSIDE THE BUILDING IS RESTRICTED TO 9:00 AM – 12:00 NOON ON FRIDAY November 16<sup>th</sup>, due to the Collie Club of Canada National Specialty beginning at 1:00. The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. daily**

- To comply with **CITY OF MONCTON** regulations **NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.**
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The CCC will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The CCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the CCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made. .
- The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and it’s entrances.
