#### CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB

Non-Member Participation Fee

(Effective January 1, 2011)

Policy:

Non-member participation fee

a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.

The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay

the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and

titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned

by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Information:

A non member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.

There are 2 options for non-members:

a) Join the CKC

b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the

caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.

The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points,

titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs, titles, or awards earned and is assessed against the

owner(s).

Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club

or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles

and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.

Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once

cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog. Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc. earned will automatically be cancelled

without further notice.

The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points,

titles, legs and is not prorated.
