GRAND CHAMPION

(synopsis only – full details posted on CKC website)

Points towards a Grand Championship cannot be gained until a dog completes its Canadian Championship. The accumulation of points began January 1, 2013. The dog must compete in the Specials Only class. Twenty points are needed for the title (the forms are available for download from the CKC website and it is the responsibility of the owner to keep track and when they reach the 20 points, submit the form to CKC who will verify the wins, and if correct will issue a certificate). In the 20 points there needs to be a minimum of 1 Best of Breed and at least 2 – 2 point wins. The scale of points is the same as for regular championships. A judge will select Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch (the latter 2 will be chosen from the remaining Specials dogs competing, if any in competition). The points are based on the total number of dogs defeated

12 – 18 MONTH CLASS ...12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED...for dogs born in Canada. Champions in any country Excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor ...This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner, breeder. The handler <u>must</u> be the owner, co-owner and breeder, co-breeder of the dog.

OPEN ...for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY.....for dogs individually registered in the C.K.C. records or Who possess an ERN number and who have earned all of the championship points Required for Championship status at the time of the closing of entries for the show. Specials dogs shall compete for the Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex award. Entry of a "Listed" dog is not Permitted in "Specials Only"

Non Regular Classes

Exhibition OnlyNo dog so entered may compete in any Regular Class. All dogs entered for Exhibition Only will be listed in the catalogue. Where applicable listing fee must also be paid.

Brace Class.... This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

Veteran Class - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

Sexually Altered Class Eligibility for the Sexually Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes.

Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female

Dogs will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

CLASSIFICATION - OBEDIENCE

Novice A for any purebred dog that has not won the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog maybe entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner, co-owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its U.D. (Utility Dog) title in Canada or elsewhere, shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Novice B for any purebred dog that has not won the title C.D. (Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "sit" and "down" exercises. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for entry in this class.

Open B for any purebred dog that has won the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the "sit" and "down" exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog that has won the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs that have won the title of U.D. may enter this class. A dog eligible for entry in the Utility class is also eligible for entry in the Open B class at the same trial.

Utility A for any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No Person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

Utility B Exercised will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

Novice C – This class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D CDX UD or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Pre-Novice – This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Novice Classes. This class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Only dogs that have not earned the title of C.D. may enter this class

Intermediate Novice- This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Intermediate Novice Classes. This class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of CD CDX or UD or any other Obedience Trial Championship title. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Only dogs that have not earned the title of C.D. may enter this class

PLEASE NOTE: We will refund entry fees for bitches entered in Obedience that come in season after entries close, with a vet certificate.

CLASSIFICATION – RALLY

Rally Novice A – Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Novice B – Any dog may complete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Rally Advanced A – This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title or any CKC Novice obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

Rally Advanced B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Rally Excellent A – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families.

Rally Excellent B – This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

- 1. The Club reserves the right to decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or to refuse to receive the entry of any dog, or remove from the show building /grooming building any dog, on account of disease or viciousness, In the case of non-acceptance, the fees shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have claim or recourse against the organization holding the shows, or against any official connected therewith for the refusal of any entry. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the shows.
- 2. The officials of the show-giving club are responsible for the conduct of the exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent
- **3.** A judge officiating at a show held under C.K.C. Rules shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the Show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. (DSC 4.1.3)
- **4.** There will be no refunds for overpayments of duplicate entries. - **5.** The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, loss, or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons, or the contents of commercial booths. See agreement on back of entry forms.
- **6.** The owner of a dog entered in this Show is entirely responsible for any errors in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 7. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- **8.** A judge shall have the right to measure in the ring and weigh or have weighed by the Superintendent, any dog whose breed standard lists height or weight as a disqualification. The decision of the Show Superintendent reported to the judge shall be final in the determination of the weight. The decision of the judge shall be final in the determination of all disqualification's (DSR 4.5.1)
- 9. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Champion Show held under C.K.C. Rules cannot again be shown at a Show under C.K.C. Rules until the dogs has been examined by an official committee appointed by the C.K.C. and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for Reinstatement must accompanied by a fee which fee shall be forfeited to the C.K.C. if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this Rule shall be cancelled by the C.K.C., and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 11. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that you exercise control and restraint over children on the days of these shows.
- 12. The Show committee reserves the right to restrict exhibitor's space.

**Note: Dogs left in the building are the responsibility of the owner/agent. Neither the members of Mt Cheam Canine Association or Heritage Park Management will be held responsible for the well geing of any animal entered or not entered at the show
