Please keep a diligent eye on your dog at all times. When outside of the trial ring, dogs should be crated or on a short leash and under control. Leash rules will be STRICTLY enforced at this show with a zero tolerance policy for dogs that are off leash or leashes that are not being held by handlers. Anyone in breach of these rules will be asked to leave the trials.

Failure to pick up after your dog or permitting your dog to relieve themselves on the trial precincts (including the building) will result in dismissal from the trials. Please do not permit your dog to urinate or defecate on the surrounding buildings. There is a fenced off leash area to the east of the training facility where dogs may be exercised.

A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

PLEASE NOTE: A service charge of 10% assessed by DogShow.ca for entries submitted. Please review the dogshow.ca rules regarding refunds for their fees. All fees must accompany your entries. No entries will be accepted without accompanying full payment. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$25.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the Prince Albert Kennel & Obedience Club Inc.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Covid-19

- All Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) regulations and protocols will be followed, including mandatory masking and proof of double vaccination status prior to entry to the trial grounds
- Anyone exhibiting any Covid-19 symptoms must not attend the trials
- Access to the building will be limited to judges, handlers/trial participants and volunteers.
- Benching is available but must be socially distant. To maximize space, no X-pens allowed.

Obedience Trial Rules

CKC RULE 4.6.1 – INDIGNITIES TO A JUDGE A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Further, this rule also includes a club official, volunteer, or any participant at our events.

6.5.2 – When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the trial giving club must refund the entry fee and listing fee providing the trial secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

6.7.6 – A dog that bites or attempts to bite another dog or a person outside the ring may be removed from the trial by the Trial Committee Chair.

20.7 – It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it seems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

1 – The Obedience Trial Chairperson is in complete charge of the trial. The Club shall have the right to remove any person from the show.

2 – No dog will be allowed in the building or on the grounds unless entered in the trials.

3 – No dog is to be left off leash at any time on or near the grounds of the trial except in the obedience ring. Violations of this rule can result in dismissal from competition. No refund shall be made.

4 – Exhibitor must wear the correct armband while in the ring.

General Instructions

1 – No dog will be allowed to compete unless entry fees have been paid in full.

2 – Refunds will not be made after the closing date for dogs that do not compete under section 6.5.2 of the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.

3 – The Trial Committee has the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

4 – The Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, either to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

5 – A judge officiating at the trial under Obedience Trial Regulations and Standards shall not be subject to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Trial Chairman shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rule. The Board of Directors shall have the power to take action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating this rule has been violated.

6 – If because of a riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the trial giving club, it is impossible to open or to complete the trials, no refund of entries will be made.

7 – Fees must accompany your entries. Tendering a NSF cheque shall be considered an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$ 25.00 fee charged for any NSF cheque issued. No post-dated cheques will be accepted. Over payments will be donated to the club trophy fund.

The Following Temporary Allowable Obedience Rules Changes will be followed:

- The handler will place their leash etc., in a designated spot and pick it up at the end of their run. A ring steward will not bring your leash to you. Your dog must leave the ring on leash and under control.
- Regardless of Saskatchewan Health Authority policies in place at the time of the Trial you may be required to wear a mask while on the Trial precincts or provide proof of double vaccination status.
- Utility handlers please bring tongs as you may be required to handle your own articles.
- Ribbons, prizes and score sheets will be placed on a table outside the ring at the end of their class. The judge will announce scores and prizes.
- There will be no printed catalogues. Electronic copies can be emailed.
- Pylons will be used for figure 8 posts at all levels
- Group stays - dogs will be placed a minimum of 8 feet apart at all levels. A dog who fails to qualify any of the individual exercises is not eligible to compete in the group exercises.
