CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS:

Section 20.2. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 and over
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}includes dog awarded winners.

In order for a dog to be issued a CKC Championship Certificate the dog must: earn at least 10 Championship points under at least 3 (three) different judges, be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number, and have earned at least one 2 (two) point win at the breed or group level.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
