All cheques or money orders are payable to **Greater Victoria Dog Obedience Training Club** or **GVDOTC**.

Note: A Canadian TD title or a UTD Pre-Test Certificate are prerequisites for the UTD test.

Entrants should be familiar with the **2020 Tracking Test Rules & Regulations**, available from the Canadian Kennel Club at www.ckc.ca.

As per CKC rule 6.1.10, we ask that exhibitors not train on test grounds (University of Victoria Campus located on Finnerty Road) within 14 days of the test.

A Temporary Competition fee (\$10.50) as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

Mixed and Unrecognized breeds welcome.

U.S. Exhibitors - To pay in Canadian funds, use Postal Money Orders or the equivalent made out in Canadian dollars. Personal cheques will be accepted only if payable in U.S. funds for the full amount of the entry. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian funds" or "At par" as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. Thank you.

Entries will be accepted by **MAIL OR HAND DELIVERY** with only one entry per envelope. Only one entry per dog will be included in the draw for entry. Entrants will be notified by email or phone when their entry has been received by the Test Secretary.

Track Draw for Entry will take place at the Saanich Fairgrounds RCMP Barn located at 1528 Stellys X Road, Saanichton, BC at 6 p.m. on Tuesday September 20th 2022. A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine entry in the test or placement on an alternates list. Entrants & alternates will be notified of their positions as soon as possible following the draw.

Club Worker Option At the entry draw, one UTD track will be reserved as per CKC Rule 6.6.2 as per GVDOTC policy.

Refunds - Entry fees for dogs NOT entered in the Test will be refunded within 10 days of the tracking test. If a dog is withdrawn after the closing date, refunds will only be given if their place is taken by an alternate.

Bitches in season will be allowed to compete and will run last. Pinch or prong collars are not allowed on the Test grounds.

Rendezvous - Scheduled for 8:00 a.m. Saturday October 1st 2022 in the Tim Hortons parking lot located at the intersection of Shelbourne and Cedar Hill Cross Road (3749 Shelbourne St, Victoria, BC V8P 5N4) where entrants will draw lots for the order of the tracks. Sanitizer will be available and must be used before handling the draw items.

AWARDS & NO-HOST LUNCHEON: All exhibitors receiving a "pass" will be awarded a ribbon and a keepsake pin, which will be awarded at the test site or at a lunch following the event (TBA).

Discipline Regulation: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. Non-member participation fee – Effective January 1, 2011

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
