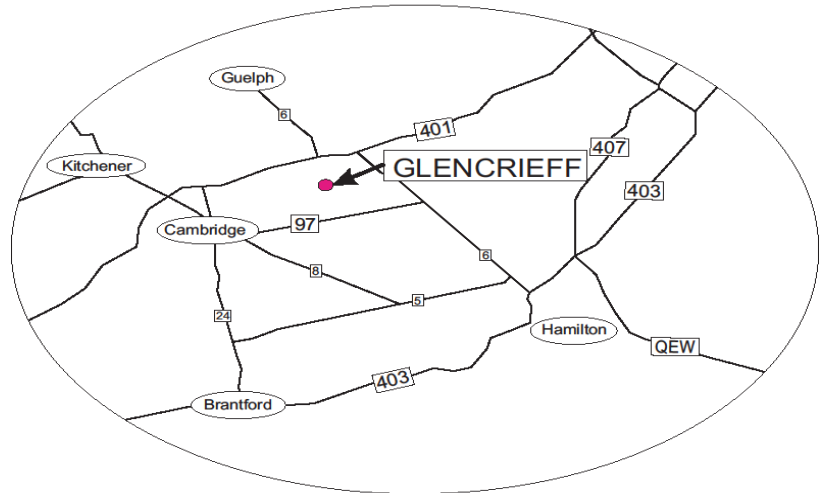

NRCC Fee: Effective 2018, the NRCC is taking a proactive role to ensure future funding for National events. The NRCC is asking member clubs to collect \$5.00 per dog competing in each All Age Stake held. Fees collected will be submitted to the NRCC Treasurer. At the end of the trial season, 100% of the funds collected will be distributed retroactively to the Host Club(s) for that year.

A \$11.30 fee must accompany any entry form of dogs for which an individual CKC registration or ERN number is not shown. A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) may be obtained by contacting the CKC. Separate entry forms must be completed for each stake the dog is entered. Scratches/refunds for dogs withdrawn after the closing date for reasons other than stated in the CKC Retriever Field Trial rule book will not have their entry fees refunded. Canadian residents who are non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot be awarded a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or membership fee to the CKC.

PLEASE NOTE A temporary competition fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

Bitches in Season **may not compete** and must be cancel from the trial

POINT SYSTEM

There is a maximum of 1 point per event in each of the following categories:

a) ENTERING & PARTICIPATING

- 1 Point for each event entered and participated in.
Obedience, Rally, Tracking, Scent Detection, Hunt Test, Working Certificate Tests, Conformation, and Canine Good Neighbor.

b) PASSING

- 1 Point for passing in the class you entered. Obedience, Rally, Tracking, Scent Detection, Hunt Test, Working Certificate Tests, Conformation, and Canine Good Neighbor.

c) PLACING IN A CLASS AT A SPECIALTY SHOW

- 1 Point for placing first to fourth in a class at either Specialty Show.

d) TOP WINS

- 1 Point for top wins in either Obedience Trials or Specialty Shows:
High In Trial, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite, Best Puppy, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Select Dog, Select Bitch, and Judges Award of Merit.
