CLASSES

Regular Standard Classes:

Agility Novice Class "A" For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country with any organization. A dog that has met the requirements for a Novice title, may continue to compete in the Novice A class in those trials that have been previously entered providing the entries have closed. If the entries have not closed, the dog must be moved to Novice B.

Agility Novice Class "B" For agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and, for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any organization.

Agility Intermediate Class The Intermediate class is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice Title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent Class "A" The Excellent A class is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Agility Excellent Class "B" The Excellent B class if for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

Regular Jumpers With Weaves Classes:

Novice "A" Jumpers With Weaves

Novice Jumpers With Weaves A is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.

Novice "B" Jumpers With Weaves

Novice Jumpers With Weaves B is for agility instructors and Judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice Jumpers With Weaves title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves, and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any organization.

Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves Class

The Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves class is open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Jumpers With Weaves title, and to those dogs that have acquired the Intermediate Jumpers with Weaves Title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Excellent Jumpers With Weaves Title.

Excellent "A" Jumpers With Weaves Class

The Excellent Jumpers With Weaves A class is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate Jumpers With Weaves Title, but have not yet earned the Excellent Jumpers With Weaves Title.

Excellent "B" Jumpers With Weaves Class

The Excellent Jumpers With Weaves B class is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent Jumpers With Weaves title or the Master Excellent Jumpers With Weaves title.

Selected Class

A dog may be entered in both the Standard Class and Jumpers With Weaves Class in each trial, however they must enter only Regular or Selected at any given show weekend. A dog may be switched back and forth in Regular and Selected but not during the same set of trials.

The Selected Classes follow the Agility trials Rules and Regulations. The courses will be the same as in the regular classes but will have adjusted heights and course times (see Section 12.5.8 of the Rule book)

Veterans Class (NEW CLASS)

At the option of the handler, a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Any new titles earned will be designated with the letter 'V' for Veteran following the title (e.g. AGMXV).

All Veterans will compete as if running in the Selected Classes at one or two jump heights lower than regular and with the 10% additional time allocated for the Selected Class.

Moving Up (ARR 6.8.1)

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number or a Performance Event Number (PEN) and has received 3 qualifying scores from a least 2 different judges, may be transferred to the next level provided that a written or electronic request is received not less than one hour prior to the commencement of each trial or in accordance with the conditions advertised in the premium list.

SAME DAY MOVE UPS WILL BE ALLOWED as per Rule 6.8.1

Bitches in Season (ARR 6.10.1 & 6.10.2)

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. The Judge of an agility trial must remove from competition any bitch in season

When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The trial-giving Club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee. The refund and the terms thereof must be clearly stated in premium list.

Upon proof as per the above Rule any bitch that comes in season to interfere with them entering the trial, monies will be refunded

Height Divisions – Chapter 10

10.1.1 The following jump height divisions shall be used in all trial classes:

8" – for dogs 10" and under at the withers

12" - for dogs over 10" up to and including 14"

16" – for dogs over 14" up to and including 18"

20" - for dogs over 18" up to and including 22"

24" – for dogs over 22" at the withers

10.1.2 The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Selected classes:

4" – for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers

8" – for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers

12" - for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers

16" - for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers

20" – for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

8.4.5 Dogs entering the Selected Classes must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice Level. A dog may continue to compete at each level until a qualifying score at the next higher level is earned.

Non-Member Participation Fee

(Effective January 1, 2011)

Policy:

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay

the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and

titles being cancelled.

c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Information:

A non member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.

There are 2 options for non-members:

- a) Join the CKC
- b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the

caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.

The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points,

titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs, titles, or awards earned and is assessed against the

owner(s).

Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club

or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles

and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.

Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once
