Canadian Bred - born in Canada, champions in any country excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor - owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Open – for all dogs

Specials Only – dogs which have a recorded CKC registration number or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status.

Non Regular Classes

Baby Puppy ~ for dogs 3 to 6 months. No points will be awarded.

Veteran Class – for dogs at least 7 years of age or older. Dogs do not compete for Best of Breed from this class.

Altered Class - for any dogs that have been neutered or spayed.

Exhibition Only - for all dogs (not entered in competition)

Additional Rosette and Award will be offered for:

Best Bred by Exhibitor – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co owner and breeder/co breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards. The ring steward must be advised that you intend to compete for this award. Awards will be awarded at group and show level.

Best Brace – for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). Both dogs are required to entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. A Brace should be judges as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. A Brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

Providing the correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. NO entry will be accepted that is not complete or without full payment.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors:

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

24-12-3. Non member participation fee

a) An annual non member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled

Attention foreign exhibitors:

All dogs that are foreign born and have foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose or entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). Simply mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque, money order, Visa, or Master Card number payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Forward your request to The Canadian Kennel Club Shows and Trials Division at 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, ON M9W 3Z9.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior Handling - Sat, June 18 and Sun, June 19 during the lunch break.

This event will be held on Saturday and Sunday during the lunch break. All dogs handled must be entered in this competition must be entered in one of the official classes on the day of the event. Rosettes will be awarded for first placement in each class and the Best Junior Handler Overall, as designated by the CKC.

Classes are as follows:

Pee Wee – ages 4 to 6

Junior Novice – ages 7 to 10 who have not won 6 first places in the same class

Junior Open – ages 7 to 10 who have won 6 first place awards

Intermediate Novice – ages 11 to 14 who have not won 6 first place awards

Intermediate Open – ages 11 to 14 who have won 6 first place awards

Senior Novice – 15 to 18 who have not won 6 first place awards

Senior Open – 15 to 18 who have won 6 first place awards

The competition ages are determined as the age of the child on December 31st of the year preceding

ATTENTION: CKC JUNIOR HANDLING RULES - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016-

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handler Number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided here under. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to the Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any other points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- Showing correct information on the entry forms is the responsibility of the entrants. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
- No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Email or fax entries will be accepted provided that they are on a recognized CKC entry form and are signed by the exhibitor or agent.
- Post dated cheques ARE NOT acceptable. Tendering an NSF cheque or declined credit card as payment of entry fees shall be considered non payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$ 25.00 NSF SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL NSF CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS
- Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, sick. lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge or barred from the competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
- 5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date: 8.7.1 An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary no later than the official closing date and time as stated in the premium list. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.
- The entry of a dog cannot be altered or cancelled after the entries close, except as provided by the Dog Show Rules.
- After the closing of the entries, an identification/receipt will be emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Judging schedules may be downloaded at www.DogShow.ca within a reasonable time after closing date.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- 9. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at the Show held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the discipline committee shall have the authority to take action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 10. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either the dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show and Trials giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
- 11. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to compete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 12. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, CKC Dog Shows Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- 13. ACCORDING TO CITY BY LAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in the designated areas. Anyone not following STOP AND SCOOP POLICY will be excused from the shows and trials. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs, both inside and outside the show building. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to eject from the show anyone at the show at the show who does not cleanup after their dog.
