General Information

This trial will be run in accordance with CARO rules and regulations – the judge will give a general briefing immediately before the first walk through of the day, please plan to attend.

All dogs must be registered with CARO – registration may be done online at http://www.canadianrallyo.ca/page/registerdog

Or, you may submit a registration form with your entry, with a cheque made out to CARO.

This is a titling event under CARO rules and regulations. CARO is open to all dogs being at least six (6) months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds, except bitches in season or dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans. There will be ribbons and prizes for the high score in each class. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog/handler team who achieves a score of 170 or better, for individual dog classes, or a score of 180 or better, for team events. You will also receive your dog's score card for each run you perform.

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless or the reason for such dismissal. However, refunds will be issued for dogs that come into heat or are injured, provided a veterinarian's certificate is received by the Trial Secretary.

Dogs can be shown on a flat buckle or snap collar or plain harness. No choke, martingale, prong or shock collars, head halters or no-pull harnesses are allowed. Leashes should be made of fabric or leather and be long enough to provide adequate slack. Dogs at the advanced or excellent level are not required to compete with a collar.

Food and toys: Food or toys are allowed as a reward at the Novice and Advanced level only. The food or toy should only be in the owner's hand when it has been taken out of the pocket to be given to the dog. It should then be returned to the pocket before the team moves on to the next station. During and between stations, all food or toy rewards must be contained in pockets. The food or toy must be kept in the pocket on the opposite side to which to the dog is heeling or it will be considered a lure. A toy reward is defined as an inactive toy (no sound or light emitted).

Touching the Dog: Upon successful completion of a station, the owner may choose to briefly pet or touch the dog as a reward. However, any petting or touching that significantly interrupts the flow of the performance shall incur deductions accordingly at the discretion of the Judge."

Physically-challenged handlers and dogs are encouraged to compete in RallyO. Modifications of the course for both handler and dog are permitted at the Judge's discretion. It is also at the Judge's discretion whether or not a dog will be allowed to compete. If the handler has any concerns regarding the Judge's decision or wishes to challenge it, the handler should be prepared to present a letter from a veterinarian stating that the dog is fit to compete. The Judge will consider this in his/her final decision. As all injuries are not always obvious or consistent, the Judge shall have the final discretion on the day of the trial. All requests for modifications to a course must accompany the Entry Form (Registration Form) for the trial, and must be received at least one week prior to the trial. The request should be in writing and should explain the handicap and the modification(s) requested.

Veteran's (dogs over 7 years of age) may have modifications made to the course because of their age without requiring a letter from a veterinarian.

Facilities: The event will be held indoors in an astroturf ring.

There is lots of crate space, but please set up on the rubber matting, or bring mats to place under your crates/ex pens. Please wear indoor shoes on the astroturf.

Coffee and snacks will be available in the morning, courtesy of the club. Lunch and refreshments will be available for purchase.

As the host club, Oxford Dog Sports reserves the right to accept or decline entries. We will also excuse any person from the trial or trial premises we deem aggressive, abusive or unsportsmanlike conduct towards another person or dog.

An officiating Judge, and/or the Chairperson of the trial, may dismiss from the trial site any person subjecting the Judge or members or the organizing committee to abuse, whether that person is competing in the trial or not.

DIRECTIONS

- From Toronto: Hwy 401 to Oxford Rd 29 (exit 250). Left over 401, right on Gobles Rd (first road) to stop sign (dead end) at Hwy 2. Right on Hwy 2, 3 km on the left (behind Nikki's Roadhouse).
- From London: Hwy 401 to Oxford Rd 2 East also known as Hwy 2(Exit 238). Oxford Rd 2/ Hwy 2 about 6 kms to Training hall on your right (behind Nikki's Roadhouse).
- From Hamilton/Niagara: Hwy 403 to Brant Rd 25, north (right) on Brant Rd 25 to Oxford Rd 2 (stop sign). Left on Rd 2 to about 4 kms to Training Hall on your left (behind Nikki's Roadhouse).

Most GPS cannot find us – please choose the crossroads of Hwy 2 and Muir Line (or Rd) – we are right on the corner.
