BITCHES COMING INTO SEASON

Bitches coming into season MAY NOT compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian's Certificate PRIOR to the commencement of the Trial.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)
