June was an active member of FPO&TC. She did not let her physical limitations stop her from living life to the fullest and on her terms. June competed with her Labrador Retrievers, Ziva and Magee, in Obedience, Rally, and Field..

Last year, shortly before our Obedience Trials, June was diagnosed with terminal cancer. She opted not to withdraw her entry in our Trials in spite of her diagnosis and physical discomfort and she and Ziva showed up in style, winning a High in Trial, 4 High in Classes, and a 2nd in Trial!

When her photo was posted and shared over the internet and in the CKC Newsletter, June was humble. When told of the comments on social media about what an inspiration she was to others with physical challenges, she said “The idea of me inspiring anyone...” as if she couldn’t quite believe it. Yet she inspired all of us. June faced the end of her life as she lived – with a steely determination, generous heart, keen wit, humour and much courage.

In June’s honour we have a special prize this year for the highest scoring senior handler (65+) of the weekend.

Entry Fees

- \$5** Exhibition Only

- \$8.93** Listing Fee* for **EACH TRIAL**. *This is only paid if the entered dog is eligible for but does not possess individual registration with the Canadian Kennel Club.

The entry of a dog at a trial must be accompanied by the entry fee. Conditional entries or entries accompanied by post-dated cheques will not be accepted.

The club must reject an incomplete entry form and promptly return it to whoever submitted it, be it the owner, lessee or authorized agent.

Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club.

Payment of Fees

ATTENTION: FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please purchase Bank Drafts of Money Orders Payable in CANADIAN DOLLARS. Personal cheques must be payable in US dollars. Please do not mark them payable in "Canadian Funds" or "at par" as such items are not readily cleared through banks.

Rules & Regulations

It is the responsibility of each competitor to be familiar with and abide by the Canadian Kennel Club Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations Effective January 1, 2015.

Discipline

Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club reserves the right to remove any person from these trials. The Trial Chair shall have full control of this event which will be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club rules.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a trial held under the CKC Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Females In Season

When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the Trial. The entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be refunded.

Non-Member Participation Fee

Canadian Resident non-CKC members competing with a wholly owned dog cannot win an award or title unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. The Canadian Resident Non-member Participation Fee is \$59.40 plus GST. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Move Ups

A dog that has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules, may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the Trial Secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE TRIAL, schedule permitting.

Please note that smoking is prohibited on the property.

Rules Governing These Trials

1. Dogs must be kept under control at all times and on leash at all times within the building with the exception of the obedience ring.
2. Collars other than those specified in these rules are not allowed within the venue. Violation of this rule may result in removal of the dog from further competition at the trial.
3. Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club will use all reasonable care to ensure the safety of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, loss or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children during these trials.
4. If for any reason beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the trials no refund of entry fees will be made.
5. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of each handler to be ready with his dog at ringside when required, without waiting to be called.
6. Any dog entered and received at an obedience trial must compete in all exercises of all classes in which it is entered, unless excused by the judge, official veterinarian, superintendent, or the trial chair.
7. Eligibility to enter specific obedience classes is detailed in the Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations. Entrants should review these requirements before entering the trials to ensure they are entered in the correct class. FPO&TC will not be held responsible for incorrect entries.
8. Every dog entered in an approved obedience trial must be one of the following: registered with the CKC; have an Event Registration, Performance Event or Canine Companion number; eligible for registration with the CKC; or, have a Miscellaneous Certification number if it belongs to a CKC listed breed.
9. Please keep the building and grounds clean. Please pick up after your dog.
10. With the exception of HIT and HIC trophies exhibitors must return the enclosed "Trophy Eligibility Sheet" form with their entry form to signify the trophies for which they wish to compete.
