All perpetual trophies shall remain in the possession of the Japanese Chin Club of Canada. Winners shall receive a keeper trophy. The person handling the exhibit in the ring shall be recognized as the agent of the owner. Delivery of any prize to the handler of the winning dog shall constitute full delivery of the prize to the rightful owner. All prizes must be claimed at the show. No prize will be mailed.

AWARD OF MERIT: At the judge's discretion, one (1) Award of Merit may be awarded for every ten (10) Japanese Chin competing at Best of Breed level. The criteria for the count shall be: all Chin entered in the Specials Only class as of the closing date, plus the Best Veteran Male and the Best Veteran Female AND *who are present in the ring for competition at Best of Breed level.* Even though a "move up" is eligible to receive an Award of Merit, the criteria for the 1:10 count shall NOT include Winners Male, Winners Female or any dog "moved up" to the Specials Only class after the close of entries. Each Award of Merit winner shall receive a rosette.

<u>CRUFTS QUALIFICATION</u>: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch and Award of Merit qualify for Crufts at this show. A Crufts qualification certificate will be presented to each winner.

THE ALBERTA KENNEL CLUB IS PLEASED TO HOST THE "BEST OF THE SPECIALTIES" COMPETITION AFTER BEST IN SHOW ON SUNDAY, JULY 31, 2016

All Best in Specialty winners and Best Puppy in Specialty winners of the associated specialties held in conjunction with the AKC Summer Classic may compete for the title of **Best of the Specialties.** The name of the competition judge will be announced with the judging schedule. The AKC will award a rosette and prize of **\$350.00 to the Best of the Specialties Winner** and a rosette and a prize of **\$150.00 to the Best Puppy of the Specialties Winner**. This is an unofficial event. There is no need to enter another class or pay an additional fee; the winners as described are automatically eligible to compete.

DOG SHOW ENTRY CLASSES

The following Canadian Kennel Club conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non- regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

REGULAR OFFICIAL CLASSES:

Junior Puppy – dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.
Senior Puppy – dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.
12 - 18 Month - dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred - dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open - all dogs.

Veterans – (CKC 12.2.1 (h) –dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only – Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration number OR Event Registration Number (ERN) and who have attained the required points for CKC Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not CKC registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy in Breed if eligible.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

Baby Puppy Class – dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The judging of Baby Puppy classes will occur after Best of Breed judging. The awards for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, and Best Baby Puppy in Breed. CKC Board of Directors Motion 23-12-10: Judges will be instructed not to disqualify dogs in this class for lack of testicles.

Stud Dog & Get - the Stud Dog and 2 or more of his Get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The Stud Dog may be neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Each Get must be entered in a Regular class.

Brood Bitch & Progeny - the Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her Progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The Brood Bitch may be spayed and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Each Progeny must be entered in a Regular class.

Brace – for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair – same colour, size, gait and same stride. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. CKC Rule 12.6.1 (c) A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead. 12.6.1 Dogs entered in Brace must be entered in either a Regular Official Class or Exhibition Only. If a dog entered in the Brace class is spayed or neutered, the dog must be entered in Exhibition Only.

Puppies 3-6 months (Exhibition Only) – dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered another dog in one of the Regular Official classes.

Exhibition Only - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular Official class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades, if provided for in the premium list.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES (CKC Rule 12.9.1): (to be judged after the Regular and Non-Regular classes)

Breeders Class - for Breeders who enter a minimum of 3 dogs and a maximum of 5 dogs, of their breeding. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the show. The **name of the breeder(s) must be identical on each and every dog entered and exhibited** in this class. The breeder must handle one of the dogs throughout the judging of the class. Ownership, dog gender and colour need not be identical. The class will be placed first to fourth based on overall excellence and quality. Each breeder's class of dogs will be presented to the judge as one unit, with the breeder and handlers working as a team to gait the dogs simultaneously in the ring. Dogs will not be individually gaited. Table examination will be at the judge's discretion. Each dog in the Breeders' Class must be entered in a Regular Official class or Exhibition Only. No neutered dog or spayed bitch may compete. This class will be judged by Mr. Joe C. Walton (USA).

Japanese Chin Parade Class - for purebred Japanese Chin who make their owners happy and proud. Let's have fun and let everyone at ringside see why your purebred Japanese Chin is a delightful companion. For example: demonstrate your dog's tricks or a special behaviour; dress your Japanese Chin (and yourself, if you wish) in a theme outfit; or simply parade your dog around the ring. You may include in the show catalogue a description (of up to 25 words) about your purebred Japanese Chin (e.g. how your Chin made a difference to someone's happiness; joined your family; overcame a major challenge in its life; or did well in competition.) Each Chin will have up to 2 minutes to be "paraded" (e.g. walked) in the ring. Multiple dogs from one household may be "paraded" at the same time; all dogs must be under control. There is no PA system for this event. No public speaking is required by the person who parades the dog(s). Each entry will receive a complimentary Chin Parade participant ribbon plus 1 free catalogue per household. **To enter this class, your Japanese Chin must be purebred AND 6 months of age or older, on the day of the show, AND entered in a Regular Official Class OR entered in Exhibition Only.** Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in the Chin Parade. A prize will be offered to the "Japanese Chin Parade - People's Choice; selected by the loudest applause.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. An ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the *Animal Pedigree Act* but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own ERN number. A CKC ERN registration form and ERN fee details can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca To obtain an ERN, mail or fax the Canadian Kennel Club the ERN form with a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate plus a certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may EITHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>Canadian resident non-CKC members</u> and are not applicable to CKC members"

- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an *Event Registration Number* or a *Miscellaneous Certification Number*.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
