MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler. When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

Prizes: Best in Veteran Sweepstakes will receive 5% of the total entry fees. Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes will receive 5% of total entry fees. First in each Class – 25% of fees for that class; Second in each class – 20% of fees for that class; Third in each class – 15% of fees for that class; Fourth in each class – 10% of fees for that class. The balance of entry fees shall be retained by the Bull Terrier Fanciers Association Inc. to cover administrative costs. Rosettes will be offered to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes. Miniature Bull Terrier dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in an Official Class at the Miniature Bull Terrier National Specialty, Specials Only or Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <u>SHALL NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GCH POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Section 15.2.4 The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT AND GCHX POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Section 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) or a Best in Multiple-Breed Specialty with at least three (3) breeds represented plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Section15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Cham- pion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements: To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

OFFICIAL CLASSES:

JUNIOR PUPPY - a dog between 6 mos. & under 9 mos. on day of show. SENIOR PUPPY - a dog between 9 mos. & under 12 mos. on day of show. 12–18 MONTHS - a dog between 12 mos. & under 18 mos. on day of show. CANADIAN BRED - a dog which is born in Canada.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS - for all dogs.

VETERANS - for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. **SPECIALS ONLY** - dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

AWARD OF MERIT - at the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed, which will be presented following Best of Breed.

<u>SEXUALLY ALTERED:</u> limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

BABY PUPPY - a dog between 3 mos. & under 6 mos. on day of show. BRACE-Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered. STUD DOG& GET-Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog may be neutered. BROOD BITCH & PROGENY - Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

Each entrant for Brace, Stud Dog, or Brood Bitch must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.

EXHIBITION ONLY – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class.
