#### **Attention Exhibitors**

#### **Non-Member Participation Fee**

In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice of either becoming a CKC member or paying the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within thirty (30) days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up. For a membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms on-line. The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January-December) in which the dog achieved its title.

#### Attention All Foreign Exhibitors

To obtain an ERN do the following: Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN.

Include full payment . Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging.

- 1. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered.
- 2. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club entries reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date as published in the Premium List cannot be accepted.
- 3. Entries cannot be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are filled in. ie. DOB, sex, place of birth etc..
- 4. Only entries accompanied by the entry fee will be accepted.
- 5. No telephone entries are allowed.
- 6. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog (s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after the closing day is prohibited.
- 7. The Kars Dog Club has the right to refuse any entry-subject to C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.
