

<u>NO</u> Hunt Test entries will be accepted after the closing date.

WC/WCI/WCX entries <u>will be accepted</u> on the day of the test up to 15 min. before the start as outlined in ENTRY INFORMATION. If, at closing, fewer than 8 dogs have entered the WC/WCI/WCX test the Labrador Owners Club may cancel the test (WC rule 2.3.1(b)). In such a case all entrants will be notified immediately after closing.

TEST DETAILS:

- Standard CKC rosettes awarded to all qualifying dogs
- Ribbons will be given out at the tailgate on Saturday. On Sunday, ribbons will be given out at the conclusion of each test.
- Pigeons and/or game birds will be used
- Shotguns may not necessarily be used
- Handlers should not wear distinctive white or light clothing except that handlers may wear handling jackets for blinds in WCX. Hunt test handlers shall be attired in dark or customary hunting attire.
- Refunds will be given for bitches in season. A Veterinarian certificate must be submitted prior to test
- Running order is by random draw within each test level
- Recommended arrival time is ½ hour prior to the start time for each stake.
- Move-ups are available for WC and WCI on Sunday May 24th.

The Labrador Owners Club is a member in good standing with the Canadian National Master Retriever Club. As of July 1, 2010 only passes at Hunt Tests hosted by clubs in good standing of the Canadian National Master Retriever Club are considered in determining eligibility to enter the National Master Hunt Test Stake.

Listing Fee: The \$9.49 (H.S.T. included) listing fee must be submitted for any dog without an individual CKC registration number or ERN number.

Post Entries: Entries for WC, WCI and WCX tests **(ONLY WC/I/X)** will be accepted at the registration table up to 15 minutes before the event start.

Moving Up: Upon successful completion of WC or WCI a dog may be moved up to the next level on Sunday May 24th 2015. Entries for dogs moving up will be accepted a minimum of **15 min prior** to the start of the desired stake.

N.S.F. Cheques: There will be a \$20.00 charge for N.S.F. cheques.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Only bank drafts or money orders in Canadian funds or personal cheques drawn on a Canadian bank will be accepted. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

IMPORTANT NOTE regarding Non-Member Participation Fee (effective January 1, 2011.

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a <u>Canadian</u> non-member of the CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

Excerpt from CKC Rules & Regulation for Working Certificate Tests (section 3.6)

3.6.1: A judge officiating at any test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the test. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the test to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Excerpt from the CKC Rules & Regulations for Hunt Tests (section 2.5)

2.5.2: Electronic collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong/pinch type collars shall not be worn by a dog on the grounds of a Hunt Test at any time during the event with the exception of those collars designed to curtail barking which may be worn by a dog while kenneled.

Excerpt from the CKC Rules & Regulations for Hunt Tests (section 3.8)

3.8.1: A judge officiating at a hunt test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the hunt test. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the hunt test to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
