ENTRY INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: This is a limited Trial. **Entries will close on Wednesday, August 9, 2013 at 8:00 pm** OR when the run limit of 16 runs per day has been reached.

Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MAILED OR E-MAILED

BITCHES IN SEASON: Are allowed to compete.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All dogs must be at least 6 months of age, and registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have A TCN, ERN, PEN, or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate.

CKC Miscellaneous Breeds cannot enter CKC events unless they have a Miscellaneous number.

ENTRY FEES: - \$60.00 for each Arena Trial for each dog entered. All fees include GST

FEO (For Exhibition Only) entries will be permitted provided regular trial entries do not fill the trial. FEO ENTRY FEE is \$40.00 per dog for each class entered.

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS:

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however; they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Due to fluctuating currency rates, if a cheque is sent in US funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do no mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par".

They will not be cleared by the banks and we will not accept them as an entry. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase a bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee. Post dated cheques will not be accepted. NOTE: Effective January 1, 2011 - Non-Member Participation Fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee (\$57.60 + taxes). This is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor who should correspond with the CKC directly. For more information, go to:

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN)

The TCN **MUST** be obtained from the CKC prior to entering any CKC event. TCN's will replace the previous system of entering events with dogs as "listed" and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

If a CKC registration number is received after the closing date but prior to the date of the show, this number may be added to the entry and noted in the marked catalogue.

A CKC TCN fee of \$11.30 (GST included) per dog per trial is payable in addition to the entry fee for all dogs entered that do not have an individual CKC registration number, an ERN, a PEN or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number. TCN fees will not be refunded.

ERN Numbers - Every foreign born and owned dog that is entered in a Canadian Kennel Club event must obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN) within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. An Event Registration Number Application must be completed and submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club and the required fee (\$62.40 plus applicable taxes).

PEN Numbers - A PEN number allows an un-registerable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To apply for a PEN you must complete a CKC Performance Event Number application and forward it with the appropriate fee to the CKC (\$62.40 plus applicable taxes). Forms and further information can be obtained at the CKC web site www.ckc.ca

Note: A dog that is eligible for a PEN number may not be entered as a listed dog.

ENTRIES: No entries may be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries except as provided for in the rules. **Incomplete entries will be returned.** No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fees. Telephone and email entries cannot be accepted. Entries submitted by courier must be sent "Signature not required". Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Confirmation emails of entry and judging schedules will be sent to competitors as soon as possible after the closing date.

ALTERNATES: An alternates list will be compiled in the order entries are received. Alternates may be allowed to run in the place of absent dogs if the Trial Secretary is notified preceding the trial of the dog's pending absence. Entry fees for an absent dog replaced by an alternate dog shall be refunded to the absent owner's dog. Alternate dogs which are not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded.

MOVE UPS: A dog that has satisfied the requirements for a title may be moved up to the next level provided that the request is received not more than 3 days or less than one hour prior to the commencement of the trial in accordance with the conditions advertised in the premium list. Move up forms will be available at the Trial Secretary's table.

RULES

1. The Australian Cattle Dog Club of Canada, Mayrich Kennels, and event organizers will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to either dogs, exhibitors or property. Dogs must be kept under control at all times, and must be kept on leash except when competing.
2. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a Herding Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
3. The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage, or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC.
4. Only dogs entered in these trials (stock dogs accepted) will be allowed within the precincts of the trial.
5. The precincts of the trial will be from the road to the barn and from the house to and including the test/trial field.
6. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs.
7. Water will be available for dogs to cool off in or drink
8. There is limited shade. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own shade, crates, etc.
9. Lunch will NOT be provided for entrants, but a BBQ, power, mini fridge, microwave and tables are available for use. There are no restaurants close to the site and food will not be available on site.
10. Exhibitors must sign the waiver form before being allowed to compete.
11. Maximum time allowed for each run will be set by the course director and announced at the handlers' meeting. The course design for each class will be decided upon by the course Director, approved by the judge and posted one hour before the start of the trial.
12. Events will be held rain or shine with the exception of lightning. Dress for the weather.
13. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their dogs while they are on the trial grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates except when competing.
14. STOCK: Test/Trial runs will use 3 head of cattle.

Please keep the site clean. Good luck to all our exhibitors!

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From Guelph: Head northwest on Wyndham St N towards Cork St E. Continue onto Eramosa Rd/County Rd 124 – continue to follow County Rd 124 (travel 16.9 km). Turn left onto County Rd 26 (travel 11.9 km). Turn left onto Eramosa Garafraxa Townline (travel 300 m). Destination on the left.

From the NORTH (Orangeville): Head west on Broadway toward Second St (travel 3.7 km). Continue straight onto Dufferin County Road 109 (550 m). Turn left onto County Rd 3/Dufferin Rd 3 (travel 16.7 km). Continue onto County Rd 18 (travel 2.8 km). Turn left onto County Rd 26 (travel 3.1 km). Turn right onto Eramosa Garafraxa Townline. (300 m). Destination on the left.

From Toronto Take Hwy 401 West (towards London). Take exit 320 for Regional Road 25 N. . Merge onto County Rd 25 N (travel 16.0 km). Keep right at the fork and continue to follow County Rd 25 N (travel 2.3 km). Continue onto County Rd 125 (travel 7.9 km). Turn left onto County Rd 124 (travel 2.9 km). Turn right onto County Rd 26 (travel 11.9 km). Turn left onto Eramosa Garafraxa Townline (travel 300 m). Destination on the left.

HOW TO: APPLY FOR A TCN ONLINE

A TCN (Temporary Competition Number) allows a dog that is eligible for CKC registration and/or an Event Registration Number (ERN) to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

1. Visit www.ckc.ca and click the red LOGIN button at the top right hand side of CKC's homepage.

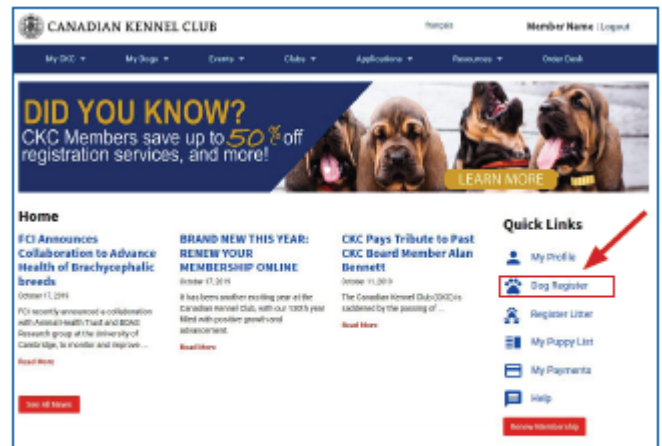


2. On the login page, login to your Portal account.

Registration of a Canadian Born dog that is a CKC recognized breed (can also compete in events)

Competing in Events Only

Canine Companion Number (CCN) - Allows mixed breed and purebred dogs of breeds not recognized by CKC to participate in some CKC performance events.

Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) – Allows listed breeds and purebred breeds not fully recognized or registered with CKC to enter an event and obtain titles. An MCN must be obtained prior to entering an event.

Performance Event Number (PEN) - Allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC- recognized or listed breed to participate in most performance events.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Allows a dog that is eligible for CKC registration and/or an Event Registration Number (ERN) to participate in CKC events on a temporary basis. Dogs must be fully registered in order to receive titles.

7. Complete the Dog’s Information section with the appropriate Information.
8. Under the Owner section, add information for at least one contact (for the primary owner).

- A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.
- The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.
- A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a PEN (Performance Event Number) or CCN (Canine Companion Number).
